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BJP RETAINS GUJ FOR 7TH TERM, LOSES HP

Party wins 156 of 182 seats with 52.5% votes; Congress reduced to 17 in worst-ever show in Guj; AAP gets 5

Riding on a pro-incumben-cy vote despite helming the State for 27 long years, the BJP delivered its "best-ever" performance on Thursday by storming back to power in Gujarat for the seventh straight time bagging 156 of the 182 Assembly seats and garnering 52.5 per cent of the votes.

In a stupendous performance in the home State of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the BIP restricted its main challenger, the Congress, to its worst-ever tally of 17 seats as the emerging third force, the AAP, made a major dent into the latter's votebank but could win only 5 seats as against its tall claims of forming the Government.

At 27.3 per cent, the vote share of the Congress, which had bagged 149 seats in 1985, is almost half of BJP while the AAP cornered a decent 12.9 per cent. But even put together, their vote share does not surpass that of the BJP's, reflecting the enormity of the BJP's landslide win.

The ruling BJP surpassed its record of 127 seats which

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DEEPAK K UPRETI ■ NEW DELHI Minister in 2002 and achieved the 150-seat target set for 2022 by its chief strategist Amit Shah. Before the BJP, the Communist Party of India (Marxist) was the only party to have won seven straight Assembly elections but that it did with a front of coalition parties.

BJP's Chief Ministerial

candidate Bhupendra Patel, who will take oath on December 12, cornered over 80 per cent of the vote share in his Ghatlodia constituency winning the seat by a margin of about 1.92 lakh votes. Modi and Shah will participate in the oath-taking ceremony, said State BJP chief CR Patil. Another big winner was BJP's Minister of State for Home Harsh Sanghavi, who won the Majura seat in Surat by a margin of over 1.16 lakh

votes.

The huge victory of the BJP is electorally significant as bagging over 50 percentage votes is rare in State polls. With the seventh consecutive and emphatic win in Gujarat, the BJP could now showcase it as a curtain raiser to the 2024 Lok Sabha polls which are

Cong wins 40, BJP 25, AAP zero in **68-member House**

Himachal Pradesh voted for a change as the ballot boxes were opened on Thursday with the Congress romping home comfortably and demolishing the BJP's hope of returning to power once again in the hill State.

Dev Bhoomi, as Himachal is called, did not spring any sur-prise as it has been throwing incumbent Governments out of power for the last four decades and it continued with this tradition by giving the Congress 40 seats and the BJP 25.

The Independents won 3 in the 68-member Assembly. Apart from other factors, what helped the Congress was the complete demolition of the AAP, which failed to eat into the Congress vote bank or get the anti-incumbency votes, failing to open its account in the State.

Chief Minister Jairam Thakur conceded the party's defeat later in the afternoon and submitted his resignation to the Governor but only after a see-saw battle that took a decisive turn towards the

victorious Congress, Pratibha Singh, surrounded by party workers, supporters, and a few MLAs, thanked the voters of the State for trusting the party. She and her son Vikramaditya Singh, who won from Shimla Rural for the second time, remembered Virbhadra Singh, the towering figure of State politics, who died last year.

Many political analysts in the State believe that his death triggered a sympathy factor for his widow, son, and the party resulting in the victory, despite Prime Minister Narendra Modi campaigning vigorously in the State and BJP president IP Nadda having his political

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Congress ousts BJP to form government in Himachal Pradesh; Race for new CM begins

A united Congress defeats BJP as true to tradition, incumbent government is voted out of power

AMITABH SHUKLA SHIMLA

Voters of Himachal Pradesh voted for a change as the ballot boxes were opened on Thursday with the Congress romping home comfortably and demolishing the Bharatiya Janata Party's hope of returning to power once again in the hill state.

Dev Bhoomi, as Himachal is called, did not spring any surprises as it has been throwing incumbent governments out of power for the last almost four decades and it continued with this tradition by giving Congress 40 seats as compared to BJP's 25. The Independents won 3 in the 68-member Assembly. Apart from other factors, what helped Congress was the complete demolition of the Aam Aadmi Party which failed to eat into the Congress vote bank or get the antiincumbency votes, failing to open its account and doing badly all over the state.

Chief Minister Jairam Thakur conceded the party's defeat later in the afternoon and submitted his resignation to the Governor but only after a see-saw battle that took a decisive turn towards the Congress. State President of the victorious Congress, Pratibha Singh, surrounded by party workers, supporters, and a few MLAs, thanked the voters of the state for trusting the people. She and her son Vikramaditya Singh, who won from Shimla Rural for the second time in a row, remembered Virbhadra Singh, the towering figure of state politics who died last year.

died last year.

Many political analysts in the state believe that his death triggered a sympathy factor for his widow, son, and the party resulting in the victory despite Prime Minister Narendra Modi campaigning vigorously in the state and BJP President JP Nadda having his political roots here. In October last year, after the death of the sixtime chief minister Virbhadra Singh, bye-elections for 4 seats (3 Assembly and 1 Lok Sabha) were held and Congress won all, indicating which way the political wind was blowing.

Dissension in the BJP was

evident from the beginning as a couple of Independents who won were denied party tickets. On the other hand, Congress gave tickets to all its sitting MLAs-19 and there was no scope for dissension there. In the campaigning too, it was a pleasant surprise to see Congress united like never before and fighting with a single-minded purpose of victory. Apart from anti-incumbency, the lackluster performance of the Jairam Thakur government in the last five years was a big drawback of the

party. He was made chief minister as the then chief ministerial candidate Prem Kumar Dhumal lost his seat in the 2017 polls. Since then, Dhumal has been cooling his heels in Hamirpur and despite rebellious supporters, he was not allowed to contest the polls this time round on the excuse of having completed 75 years of age. Though his son and Union Minister Anurag Singh Thakur went all out in the campaign, Dhumal's marginalization had an impact on some of his supporters who either rebelled or

simply looked the other way round. Though Thakur had a clean image, he lacked administrative acumen and found it hard to fill in the shoes of Dhumal who had built a support base for himself in all parts of the state.

Moreover, Himachal is a state where government servants have the ability to swing the mood of voters and their mood too swings from one election to the other. This time, the Congress's promise of bringing back the old pension scheme helped them rally

around the party and they played a significant role in the victory. Though chief minister Thakur to his credit tried to woo this section desperately in the last six months of his tenure, it was seen merely as a 'cosmetic" instead of substantial outreach. In the apple belt tial outreach. In the apple belt of the state too, there was resentment against the gov-ernment simply because the import duty of foreign-pro-duced and imported apples was not increased and the hope of the orchardists to make decent profits was dashed. In fact, the apple growers perhaps thought that despite having a double-engine government (both Centre and state), Thakur could not get one simple concession for them. Producing Apple is a huge economy in the state and there are direct and indirect beneficiary families and no government can afford to ignore their wishes. No wonder, Congress did exceedingly well in the apple belt of the state winning 7 of the 8 seats.

With a decisive victory, Congress might not fear poach-

ing now but there could be differences on the name of the new chief minister in the meeting of the legislative party, Congress is likely to convene a meeting of its legislative party either in Chandigarh or Shimla in a day or two. Chhattisgarh chief minister Bhupesh Baghel who played a significant role in the Himachal campaign and who, of late, has emerged as a troubleshooter for the party has already reached out to the victorious MLAs for a consensus on a name. It is understood that the name of the new chief minister would be decided as early as possible to keep any potential trouble away after a discussion between the high command and the newly elected MLAs. As Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, campaigned, conducted road shows and earlier chose candidates for the election, she is likely to play an important role in the decision-making process. Two names for the top political post are significant at this juncture—PCC President, Mandi MP, and widow of former CM Virbhadra Singh and Leader of Opposition and for-mer journalist and Virbhadra

Pb to prepare a comprehensive stray cattle management plan

Taking serious note of the accidents caused by stray cattle in the state, Punjab Government has decided to prepare a comprehensive plan for the preservation and management of stray cattle, besides setting up a dedicated committee to formulate a uniform policy for providing adequate compensation to the victims of accidents involving stray animals. Chief Secretary Vijay Kumar Janjua, presiding over a high-level meeting on Thursday, directed the Local Government and Rural Development and Panchayats Departments to identify stray animals roaming freely in their respective areas and make arrangements for leaving them in gaushalas after holding them using special vehicles. He asked the officials of the Governance Reforms Department to create a tracking system equipped with geomapping to find out where the stray cattle are roaming, and a control room can also be set up, where stray animal carrying vehicles can be accessed easily for stray animal transportation up till gaushalas. "Accidents involving stray animals are a matter of great concern...The concerned departments should work in tandem for prevention of stray animals," said Janjua.



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

Win-win-win

BJP, Cong and AAP have reasons to rejoice but they can't afford to ignore certain issues

esults of Assembly elections in Gujarat and Filinachar Fragoritation and BJP, Congress poll have pleased every party — at least, that's what leaders of the BJP, Congress and AAP are saying. The BJP is happy that it won Gujarat with an unpreceding collabse, which was a case of esults of Assembly elections in Gujarat and Himachal Pradesh and the MCD dented landslide. Evidently, the Morbi cable bridge collapse, which was a case of monumental incompetence and corruption, had little impact on the poll. Also forgotten was the mismanagement during the deadly Delta wave of Covid-19. In the 2017 Assembly election, the saffron party had just managed to form Government with 99 seats, with the Congress not much behind with 77; this must have caused jitters in the BJP's State unit. But Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah, along with other top party leaders, spared no effort to register a handsome victory. In the MCD election, too, where the saffron party was estimated to



This is also Priyanka Vadra's first success in electoral politics; this may occasion an increase in her role. AAP also has reasons to be pleased with the overall results. Of course, it didn't get a landslide in MCD, but it won comfortably. Party boss Arvind Kejriwal had made tall claims about success in Gujarat but it didn't reach the double-digit mark. Still, it was able to dislodge the BJP from the local bodies in Delhi against a spirited campaign by the saffron party. Satyendra Jain's video clips, the charges against Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia and AAP's alleged involvement in Liquorgate did little to harm the party's electoral prospects. Besides, AAP, by winning a few seats in Gujarat, has now graduated to becoming a national party. The three parties, however, should not lose sight of the challenges they will face. The grand old party can celebrate its victory in Himachal, but it should also be cognisant of the fact that its decline in several States is quite steep. In Gujarat, for instance, it got just about one-tenth of the seats that its arch-rival BJP got. The BJP must beware of the problem of rebellion, which seems to have been exacerbated because of the centralisation of powers in the party. And AAP has to look beyond freebies, which didn't find many takers in Gujarat and Himachal.

new army chief has taken over from General Qamar Javed Bajwa. The new army chief is General Asim Munir. In Pakistan popularity of army Generals is as important as the popularity of politicians in their careers. General Qamar Javed Bajwa, had become quite unpopular during his last months in office. 
Our attempts to resolve any number of socio-economic and political problems have to focus on behavioural changes and social engineering

ny effective reform in the electoral process has to take into account many factors including legal and legislative ones. The steps are discussed so as to bring a holistic change with an inclusive approach. Any change in the behavioural aspect of people solicits an endeavour for awareness building. Art 324 (1) of the constitution India vests the power of superintendence, direction and control of elections in the Election Commission of India. As such ECI is the most important constitutional body having Superintendence, direction and control over the election process. This vesting of such large power also generates responsibility for ECI for smooth conduct of free and fair elections.

As a first step, ECI should also try to create awareness among people delineating the role/(voting) power of citizens to choose their representatives. Frequent publicity over print and visual media about dos and don'ts for the voters would create some awareness Collectors as the agents of ECI also may be directed to carry and convey the voice and messages of the Commission in the nook and corner of the districts and also in the interior pockets.

The vulnerable groups (tribals etc.) should be guarded heavily against exploitation and intimidation. Frequent visits to these areas, especially the day/night before the election would foil the prank of the unethical elements to win by the force of money. Any violation of code of conduct in case of the candidates or followers should warrant disqualification. District and police administration's alertness, swiftness and sincerity can nip the criminal activities in the bud. The erring and non-performing district administration officials should be taken to task by the ECI. A strong ECI, effective district administration and strong police force can make the process smooth.

In any democratic set up criminality has no role to play as being anathematic. Do we need legislation for bringing up laws to ensure free and fair elections? Generally deterrent law has three major components such as severity (severe degree of punishment), Certainty (punishment follows as a certainty wherever there is occurrence of a criminal act) and Celerity (swiftness is essential). Crime would be deterred if punishment is awarded quickly and rapidly. In the opinion of Hobbes, people are driven due to their self interest and further he stressed the importance of deterrence to make the people law abiding Cesare Beccaria stated that crime and punishment should both have a proportional deterring and deterrence value.

These three components not only attract people's faith and confidence in the system but are also most effective in electoral process and dynamics. As any strong prophylactic or curative medicine has side effects, any harsh law runs the risk of abuse. The most terrifying factor for a politician is disqualification and ban on contesting elections. If the

deterrent law would address this entailing disqualification then the success rate would still be higher and so it would deter other candidates from venturing into abuse of money

power and criminality. Strict implementation and prompt investigation and certainty of the punishment for the unscrupulous elements can bring back everything on a fair path. Electoral malpractices (Abuse of money power, intimidation of voters, post poll violence. offer of freebies, criminal use of caste card etc) should be associated with disqualification, fines and other penal provisions and that would go a long way for introducing fresh air into the system.

The role of bureaucracy is very important here. Impartiality, effectiveness, sincerity and honesty should be maintained at any cost under strict vigil of Election Commission of India. As stated previously, it is a herculean task. But search for solution for every difficult task should start at the earliest and sincerity and it can achieve the most complicated task.

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FIRST COLUMN COMMONALITIES IN G20 PRESIDENCY

Indian PM Narendra Modi has taken a whole-of-Government approach

he first round of meeting among G20 members got off to a rather colourful start earlier this week with traditional Rajasthani turbans. scarves and jackets gifted to visiting delegates in the western Indian city of Udaipur. The event kicked off several official dialogues, networking opportunities for the G20 nation sherpas, 14 participating international organisations and nine guest countries.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has taken a whole-of-government approach to what it has dubbed as one of a kind event in the history of independent India. The narrative is of India finding its rightful place on global agenda setting tables, now being the fifth largest economy, moving quickly to be the third in a few years' time.

The current government has a lot at stake in getting the messages right to a global decision making group who are likely to be part of the 200 plus plenary discussions in the run up to the leaders' summit in New Delhi in September 2023. However, an equal stakeholder in the G20 presidency is the domestic audience, who in turn, will be gearing up for one of the largest exercises in the largest democracy of the world political map, the general elections of 2024.

Prime Minister, therefore, wasted no time after casting his vote in Gujarat assembly elections to rush back to Delhi for an all-party meet on India's G20 presidency. He has urged all key parties to be a stakeholder in India's presidency and showcase the strengths of India. A careful selection of venues dotted across the Indian subcon-



tinent from northeast, right into the islands of Andaman has been planned to ensure a full experience of India for the visiting delegates.

The central government offices, state government and every public institution has been requested to start displaying some branding related to India's G 20 presidency and carefully plan regional events, aligning them with proposed plenary meetings. Plenaries have been planned keeping in mind important religious, cultural or social events in the states across India. The message is that the delegates of today are tourists of tomorrow.

One will expect a large amount of G20 branded content in cities /districts hosting these meetings, subtly pushing the message of India taking its "rightful" place on the geopolitical map. The political dividends, at least domestically, have not been overlooked and Modi ensured he held a meeting with key post bearers of the ruling party.

India has been the voice of the global South (an informal alliance of developing nations primarily in Asia and Africa, who may not be aligned with West or Russia, China worldview). This may have looked like India revisiting the cold war non-aligned movement ideology.

However, it may be worth noting that the days of Non-aligned Movement kind of grouping may be over and India, as it champions about reformed multilateralism, could bring a new interpretation to agile diplomacy while it negotiates and finds commonalities with the developed western countries and put across the pressing needs of the developing world. India has highlighted key themes of its presidency earlier this week, including technological transformation, green development and lifestyle for environment, climate financing and associated reform for multilateral finance institutions.

India would highlight its indigenously developed digital public goods stack to the global audience in the coming days. On the domestic front, India has moved the needle to designing the legal framework for the digital ecosystem (a key showcase during its presidency). As of now it is going to be a busy season for all major airports across the country.

In terms of the GSDP (Gross State



In fact, the Gujarat model of development has essentially been based on utilizing the resources of the state exchequer to create assets which work for the social and economic empowerment of the people. Works done in ensuring availability of water in Gujarat stand out as examples for other states to mobilise their resources for the long term asset creations, which the people reward also in elections.

It must now be accepted that the development model of Gujarat is all inclusive, which has made the past narrative of identity politics irrelevant. This was reflected in the BJP victory from Dariapur Assembly seat in Gujarat, which is dominated by Muslims. The BJP candidate Kaushik Jain won from here, and he must overwhelmingly have got the Muslim votes.

The BJP has also served a warning message to the AAP in the national capital. Even while the BJP lost the MCD elections after 15 years of rule, the party improved its vote share to over 39 per cent. The AAP vote share has come down from 53 per cent two years ago to 42 per cent now. The BJP is now raring to go for the next Assembly elections to overthrow the AAP by building the development plank of the party against the politics of freebies.

What is more important is that

the corruption charges against the AAP government have resonated with the people in the national capital. The BJP won the municipal wards in the Assembly constituencies of the Delhi deputy chief min-ister Manish Sisodia, jailed minister Satyendar Jain, transport minister Kailash Gehlot, Amannullah Khan, who is accused of taking money for party tickets, Akhilesh Tripathi, who also allegedly sold the AAP tickets.

This augurs well for Delhi politics, as the people in the national capital have given the message to the BJP to work hard to throw the anarchists out of power in the next Assembly elections, which would be held in 2025. At the same time, the people blessed the BJP with 104 wards in the MCD to keep a check on the AAP in the MCD and the party would not allow the anarchist politicians to fritter away all the gains made by the MCD in the last 15 years. Unlike Delhi Assembly, the AAP will not be able to throv the BJP members from the MCD meetings, and that has been ensured by the people.

The BJP faced reversal in the Himachal Pradesh Assembly elections on account of the rebel factor. But the BJP's vote share was almost at par with Congress. The BJP may have turned the tide and changed the tradition of Himachal Pradesh of voting out the incumbent government if the candidate selection had been better.

ational Education Policy 2020 recommends enhancing learning outcomes of students by involving community and volunteer efforts for one-on-one tutoring, holding extra help classes, teaching support and guidance. These objectives recommended by the NEP were conceived through the program called 'Vidyanjali'- a school volunteer initiative wherein volunteering was proposed to be done in non-monetary form directly to the schools through a tech-based com-

education. The volunteers could be local individuals, civil societies or corporates, people from the Indian diaspora and NRIs. Vidyanjali seeks community involvement in the efficient functioning of the schools in the neighbourhood, especially government and government aided schools.

Though volunteering for a social cause has been an integral part of Indian culture, the uniqueness of the Vidyanjali initiative is that it provides a tech-enabled smooth platform which connects the schools with the volunteers located in any part of the country. Very often, a common citizen is left wondering how to volunteer for a social cause and schools on the other hand look out for assistance to meet the diverse

yet small needs of the school which does not get covered in through their annual budget

Many a time, shortage of teachers leaves students deprived of education. Vidyanjali provides an opportunity to address these gaps. Launched in September 2021, with active volunteers participation, the programme is gradually gaining traction among citizens. Ukraine fight taking longer than expected: Putin

Russian President Vladimir Putin acknowledged Wednes-day that his "special military operation" in Ukraine is taking longer than expected but said it has succeeded in seizing new territory and added that his country's nuclear weapons are deterring escalation of the conflict.

"Of course, it could be a lengthy process," Putin said of the more than 9-month-old war that began with Russia's invasion Feb. 24 and has displaced millions from their homes, and killed and wounded tens of thousands. Despite its length, he showed no signs of letting up, vowing to "consistently fight for our interests" and to "protect ourselves using all means available." He reiterated his claim that he had no choice but to send in troops, saying that for years, the West responded to Russia's security demands with "only spit in the face."

Speaking in a televised meeting in Russia with members of his Human Rights Council, Putin described the land gains as "a significant result for Russia," noting that the Sea of Azov "has become Russia's internal sea." In one of his frequent he admires, he added that "Peter the Great fought to get access" to that body of water.

After failing to take Kyiv due to fierce Ukrainian resistance, Russia seized broad swaths of southern Ukraine at the start of the invasion and captured the key Sea of Azov port of Mariupol in May after a nearly three-month siege. In September, Putin illegally annexed four Ukrainian regions even though his forces didn't completely control them: Kherson and Zaporizhzhia in the south, and Donetsk and Luhansk in the east. In 2014, he had illegally annexed Ukraine's Crimean Peninsula.

In response to an increasing influx of advanced Western weapons, economic, political and humanitarian aid to Kyiv and what he saw as Western leaders' inflammatory statements, Putin has periodically hinted at his potential use of nuclear weapons. When a member of the Human Rights Council asked him Wednesday to pledge that Russia would not be the first to use such weapons, Putin demurred. He said Russia would not be able to use nuclear weapons at all if it agreed not



"If it doesn't use it first under any circumstances, it means that it won't be the second to use it either, because the possibility of using it in case of a nuclear strike on our territory will be

sharply limited," he said.

Putin rejected Western criticism that his previous nuclear weapons comments amounted to saber-rattling, claiming they were "not a factor provoking an escalation of con-

'We haven't gone mad. We are fully aware of what nuclear weapons are," Putin said. He added, without elaborating: "We have them, and they

In his televised remarks, the Russian leader didn't address Russia's battlefield setbacks or its attempts to cement control over the seized regions but acknowledged problems with supplies, treatment of wounded soldiers and limited desertions.

Russian troops have withdrawn not only from the Kyiv area and around the country's largest city, Kharkiv, but from a large part of the Kherson region. Another problem for Putin are attacks this week against air force bases deep inside Russia. He put much of the country, especially border areas, on security alert recently, and fresh signs emerged Wednesday that Russian officials are strengthening border defensive positions.

In the Kursk region bordering Ukraine, the governor posted photos of new concrete anti-tank barriers known as "dragon's teeth" — in open fields. On Tuesday, the governor had said a fire broke out at an airport in the region after a drone strike. In neighboring Belgorod, workers were expanding anti-tank barriers and officials were organizing "self-defense units." Belgorod has seen numerous fires and explosions, apparently from

reported Wednesday that Russia's air defenses have shot down incoming

In brazen drone attacks, two strategic Russian air bases more than 500 kilometers (300 miles) from the Ukraine border were struck Monday.



Supporters and detractors of the church debate whether such items are innocuous - or increase suspicions the church is a nest of pro-Russian propaganda and intelligence-gathering. What's unambiguous are

other photos shared by the agency, known as the SBU, posted as recently as Wednesday some showing an armed Ukrainian officer standing outside a church building, others showing brawny, camouflaged officers questioning clerics in long beards and cassocks.

They illustrate the increased pressure the Ukrainian government is putting on the Ukrainian Orthodox Church, with its centuries-old ties to Moscow, as the brutal Russian invasion slogs

has had religious dimensions from the start.

President Volodymyr Zelenskyy on Friday announced measures primarily targeting the Ukrainian Orthodox Church, which is one of two major Orthodox churches in Ukraine following a 2019 schism. raises the stakes as the two rival Orthodox churches vie for the loyalties of the nation's majority Orthodox population and for church properties. Prominent Ukrainian Orth-

odox Church leaders say it has loyally supported Ukraine from the start of the war and that a government crackdown will only hand a propaganda coup to the Russians, who claim to be defending Ukraine's Orthodox against persecution. "It is national suicide when

Aformer Ukrainian law-maker who U.S. Authorities say acted as a Russian agent for over a decade and tried to influence the 2020 presidential election through meetings with Rudy Giuliani has been criminally charged in New York in connection with purchases of luxury Beverly Hills real estate.

The charges against Andrii erkach, 55, of Derkach, Dnipropetrovsk, Ukraine, were announced Wednesday in Brooklyn by U.S. Attorney

Derkach has been characterized by the U.S. Government as an "active Russian agent" for over a decade. Authorities say he met multiple times during the 2020 race with Giuliani, a close Trump ally, and released heavily edited recordings of Democrat Joe Biden in an effort to disparage him. Prosecutors also say Derkach sought to fund a lavish lifestyle for himself and his family through the purchase of two Beverly Hills condominiums even as he hid his interests in the transactions from banks.

Putin denies Western accusations of nuclear saber-rattling

 $R^{ussian\ President\ Vladimir}_{Putin\ on\ Wednesday}$ described the country's nuclear arsenals as a deterrent factor in the Ukrainian conflict but demurred when challenged to make a pledge that Russia would not be the first to use

Asked by a member of the presidential Human Rights Council to commit Russia to forswearing a first strike, Putin responded that such an obligation might prevent Russia from tapping its nuclear arsenal even if it came under a nuclear attack. "If it doesn't use it first

under any circumstances, it means that it won't be the second to use it either, because the possibility of using it in case of a nuclear strike on our territory will be sharply limited," Putin said.

He noted that Russia's nuclear doctrine was based on the so-called "launch on warning" concept, which envisages the country employing nuclear weapons in the face of an imminent nuclear attack.

"It means that if we come



under strike, we strike back in response," he said.

Russia's nuclear doctrine states the country can use nuclear weapons if it comes under a nuclear strike or if it faces an attack with conventional weapons that threatens "the very existence" of the Russian state. Putin, who has repeatedly

said during the fighting in Ukraine that Russia was ready to use "all available means" to protect its territory, rejected Western criticism of nuclear saber-rattling. He pointed at former British Prime Minister Liz Truss' statement about her readiness to use nuclear weapons, saying he felt obliged to respond to that.

"I had to emphasize certain things in response," Putin said. "Her comments went largely

unnoticed, but they immediately emphasized our statements and used them to scare the world."

The Russian leader further argued that Russia's nuclear weapons serve as a tool of deterrence amid the military operation in Ukraine, which is in its 10th month.

"We haven't gone mad. We fully understand what nuclear weapons are," Putin said. "We have them, and they are more advanced and state-of-the-art than what any other nuclear power has."

He added: "We aren't going to brandish those weapons like a razor running around the world, but we naturally proceed from their existence."

"It's a factor of deterrence, not a factor provoking an escalation of the conflict," Putin said.

The Russian leader characterized the tactical nuclear weapons the United States deployed to Europe as a destabilizing factor. Russia, by contrast, hasn't deployed any nuclear weapons outside its territory, Putin said, adding that "we naturally will defend

our allies with all available means, if necessary."

Norway acquits Putin ally's son who flew drone **AP** ■ COPENHAGEN

The son of a Russian businessman close to President Vladimir Putin has been acquitted in Norway of violating a law that bars Russians from flying drones.

Andrey Yakunin, who holds both a Russian and a British passport and who lives in Italy, was arrested in Hammerfest, in Arctic Norway, on Oct. 17, after he had sailed around the Arctic Archipelago of Svalbard and along the coast of Norway.

When off Svalbard, he was responsible for two drones that he owned, and which were used several times for flights



over the archipelago which sits more than 800 kilometers (500 miles) north of the Norwegian mainland. On some occasions he piloted them himself, the court said. The 47-vear-old Yakunin had been filming with the

drone while mountaineering, glacier walking and sailing. Under Norwegian law, it is prohib-

ited for aircraft operated by Russian com-

panies or citizens "to land on, take off from or fly over Norwegian territory." Norway is not a member of the European Union but mirrors its moves and decided on the ban earlier this year after the invasion of Ukraine.

US appeals ruling that would lift asylum restrictions

¬he US government said on Wednesday it is appealing . a court ruling that would lift asylum restrictions that have become the cornerstone of border enforcement in recent years.

But there was no indication that the appeal would scuttle a December 21 deadline set by a federal judge to end asylum restrictions that have been used to expel asylum seekers.

The disputed enforcement rule first took effect in March 2020, denying migrants' rights to seek asylum under US and international law on grounds of preventing the spread of

COVID-19. The Homeland Security Department said it would file an appeal with the US Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia, challenging some aspects of the November ruling by US District Judge Emmet Sullivan that ordered President Joe Biden's administration to lift the asylum restrictions.

Biden officials say the Department of Homeland Security continues to prepare for the December 21 deadline set by Sullivan to lift restrictions.

The restrictions were put in place under former President Donald Trump at the outset of the COVID-19 pandemic.

▼ran said on Thursday it exe-Lcuted a prisoner convicted for a crime allegedly committed during the country's ongoing nationwide protests, the first such death penalty carried out Tehran.

The execution comes as other detainees also face possible death penalty for their involvement in the protests, which began first as an outcry against Iran's morality police and have expanded into one of the most serious challenges to Iran's theocracy since its 1979 Islamic

Activists warn others could be put to death as well soon since actīvists say at least a dozen people so far have received death sentences over their involvement in the demonstrations.

The "execution of #Mohsen Shekari must be me with STRONG reactions otherwise we will be facing daily executions of protesters," wrote Mahmood Amiry-Moghaddam, the director of the Oslo-based activist group Iran Human

"This execution must have rapid practical consequences internationally."

Iran's Mizan news agency reported the execution. It accused the man of blocking a street and attacking a security force member with a machete in Tehran. The Mizan news agency, run by the country's judiciary,



identified the executed man as Mohsen Shekari

It said he had been convicted in Tehran's Revolutionary Court, which typically holds closed-door cases that have been internationally criticised in other cases for not allowing those on trial to pick their own lawyers or even see the evidence against them.

Mizan said Shekari had been arrested September 25, then convicted November 20 on the charge of "moharebeh," a Farsi word meaning "waging war against God."

That charge has been levied against others in the decades since 1979 and carries the death

Iran has been rocked by protests since the September 16 death of 22-year-old Mahsa Amini, who died after being detained by the country's morality police.

At least 475 people have been killed in the demonstrations amid a heavy-handed security crackdown, according to Human Rights Activists in Iran, a group that's been monitoring the protests since they

Iran is one of the world's top executioners. It typically executes prisoners by hanging. Already, Amnesty International said it obtained a document signed by one senior Iranian police commander asking an execution for one prisoner be "completed in the shortest possible time' and that his death sentence be carried out in public as 'a heart-warming gesture towards the security forces.



South Korea's truth body to probe foreign adoptions

South Korea's Truth and Reconciliation Commission will investigate the cases of dozens of South Korean adoptees in Europe and the United States who suspect their origins were falsified or obscured during a child export frenzy in the mid- to late-1900s.

The decision Thursday opens what could be South Korea's most far-reaching inquiry into foreign adoptions yet. Frustration over broken family connections and laundered child statuses and identities grew and demanded government attention.

The adopted South Koreans are believed to be the world's largest diaspora of adoptees. In the past six decades, about 200,000 South Koreans — mostly girls — were adopted overseas. Most were placed with white parents in the United States and Europe during the 1970s and '80s

After a meeting Tuesday, the commission decided to investigate 34 adoptees who were sent to Denmark, Norway, the Netherlands, Germany, Belgium, and the United States from the 1960s to the early 1990s. The adoptees say they were wrongfully removed from their families through falsified documents and corrupt practices.

They were among the 51 adoptees who first submitted their applications to the commission in August through the Danish Korean Rights Ğroup, led by adoptee attorney Peter Møller. The applications filed by Møller's group have since grown to over 300, and dozens of adoptees from Sweden and Australia are also expected to file applications on Friday, which is the commission's deadline for investigation requests, Møller



China's Xi at Saudi palace to meet royals

¬hinese leader Xi Jinping **C**met on Thursday with Saudi Arabia's king and the crown prince while on a visit to the kingdom, solidifying ties with a region crucial to his country's energy supplies as sanctions intensify on Russia over its war

on Ukraine. Xi arrived at Al Yamama Palace in Riyadh and was greeted by Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman, the king's assertive son who stands ready to rule the oil-rich kingdom in the decades to come. Xi shook hands with the prince as an honour guard on horseback carried Saudi and Chinese flags.

It wasn't immediately clear what the two focused on in their discussions, though Xi in a newspaper column published by Al Riyadh newspaper said "exchanges between China and Arab states date back more than 2,000 years. The column also quoted a

saying by Islam's Prophet Muhammad: "Seek knowledge even if you have to go as far as China." "The Arab people value independence, oppose external

politics and high-handedness, and always seek to make progress," Xi's column read.

He also noted that the Gulf Cooperation Council countries, which include Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates, serve as "an energy tank for world economy." China, the world's largest crude oil importer, relies heavily on Saudi oil, paying tens of billions of dollars annually to the kingdom.

Gulf Arab states are trying to re-calibrate their foreign policy as the United States turns its attention elsewhere in the world.

Russia's war on Ukraine and the West's hardening stance on Moscow — has also left the Arab countries wanting to cement ties with China. For Prince Mohammed, hosting Xi boosts his own international profile after being linked to the killing of Washington Post columnist Jamal Khashoggi.

Beyond China's oil purchases, its construction expertise could be tapped as well for Prince Mohammed's planned USD 500 billion futuristic city of Neom on the Red Sea.

Yesterday, the RBI indicated that it wants inflation to be within the band first and then move towards the target of 4 per cent, Kotak said at the CII Global Economic Policy Summit

"My sense is that there could be one more rate hike and that may be the time for thinking about a pivot, but we got to watch very closely the data, and maybe around 6.5 per cent as it looks today, subject to what happens to the world, subject to what happens to oil, subject to what happens to many other things," he said.

Kotak further said the US Federal Reserve's decision on interest rates this month will be a signal for other central banks.

"I think that is going to be a very crucial signal about what is the interest rate trajectory in the largest market and the largest



pool of money in the world, which is the UŚ," he said.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Wednesday hiked the key repo rate by 35 basis points to 6.25 per cent, the fifth straight increase since May.

Air India to invest over USD 400 million on wide-body aircraft refurbishment

¬ata group-owned full service Tata group-owned and a on Thursday said it plans to refurbish its legacy wide-body fleet, comprising 40 Boeing planes, at an investment of over USD 400 million (about Rs 3,295 crore).

The company has mandatdesign companies JPA Design and Trendworks to assist with the cabin interior design elements of the refurbishment exercise, the airline said in a statement. Of the 40 planes which are set to go for refurbishment, 27 are Boeing 787-800s and 13 Boeing 777s.

All these planes were acquired when the airline was under state ownership. The Tata Group regained control of Air India in January this year.

The first such refurbished aircraft is expected to be in service by mid-2024, as per the release. With this significant investment, Air India said it is

committed to providing its passengers with a comfortable, modern, and technologically advanced cabin.

In September, the airline announced a transformation plan, focusing on growing both its network and fleet, developing a completely revamped customer proposition, improving iability and on-time perfor

It also aims at taking a leadership position in technology, sustainability, and innovation, as well as aggressively investing in the best industry talent.

Power deficit declines to 0.1% in October from 2% in April



 $P^{\rm ower\ deficit\ or\ gap\ between}_{\rm electricity\ required\ and\ sup}$ cent in April this year to 0.1 per cent, Parliament was informed on Thursday.

"The gap between energy requirement and energy supplied has been reduced from two per cent to 0.1 per cent between the month of April, 2022 and October, 2022," Power Minister R K Singh stated in a written reply to Lok Sabha.

The data showed that the deficit was 2,752 million units (units) in April this year which came down to 124 MU in October, 2022.

The power deficit was 609 MU (0.4 per cent) in May, 796 MU (0.6 per cent) in June, 434 MU (0.3 per cent) in July, 465 MU (0.4 per cent) in August and 312 MU (0.2 per cent) in September.

In another reply to the House, the minister informed that as on March 31, 2022, the coal stock position was 25.6 Million Tonnes (MT), or 9 days of stock, and it increased to 26.1 MT on September 30, 2022 and further increased to 30.9 MT, or 11 days of stock, as on November 30, 2022.

The coal stock available at coal-based thermal power plants of the country is monitored by the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) on a daily basis. The minister informed that

as on November 30, 2022, there are 75 plants (56 per cent) out of 180 plants are having coal stock of less than 8 days as per their consumption pattern.

The gap between energy requirement and energy supplied has been reduced from two per cent to 0.1 per cent between April and October, 2022, primarily on account of various steps taken by the government, Singh stated.

According to the draft National Electricity Plan published in 2022 by CEA, the projected new coal capacity addition requirement during the period 2022-32 is 35,014 MW, which includes under-construction coal-based capacity totalling to 25,580 MW, Singh stated in another reply to the House.

India has achieved 165.94GW of renewable energy capacity till October as against the target of 175GW by 2022, Parliament was informed on Thursday.

"Against the target of achieving 175 GW of Renewable Energy installed capacity by 2022, a total of 165.94 GW of renewable energy capacity (including large hydro) has been installed in the country as on October 31, 2022," Power and New & Renewable Energy Minister R K Singh stated in a written reply to Ľok Sabha on

A capacity of 76.13 GW (of renewables) is under various stages of implementation and a capacity of 36.44 GW is under various stages of bidding, Singh informed the House.

In line with the Prime Minister's announcement at COP26, the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy is working towards achieving 500 GW of installed electricity capacity from non-fossil sources by 2030. Singh further elaborated

that so far, a total of 172.72 GW capacity from non-fossil fuelbased energy resources has been installed in the country as on October 31, 2022, which includes 119.09 GW Renewable Energy, 46.85 GW Large Hydro and 6.78 GW Nuclear Power

The Netherlands will be bidding to "change" the memories from their semi-final loss on penalties in 2014 when they face Argentina again at the World Cup on Friday, said forward Memphis Depay.
One of the tournament's

Depay was a unused substitute that day, but is expected to start this time around.

senior national team once, when youth players were used in a friendly against Lithuania because the main squad had to go into isolation because of the coronavirus.

Other candidates who had been considered besides De la Fuente, who was Spain's under-21 coach, included former Belgium manager Roberto Martínez and former Athletic Bilbao coach Marcelino García Toral.

Luis Enrique took over the national team in 2018 to start revamping the squad after its elimination in the round of 16 of the World Cup in Russia. He temporarily left because of the illness and eventual death of his young daughter, but returned in 2019.



He helped Spain reach the last four of the Nations League twice, including this season and last year, when it lost the final to France.

He also led Spain to the semifinals of the European Championship last year, losing to Italy in a penalty shootout.

Luis Enrique's contract ended after the World Cup. The former Barcelona player and coach had said moments after the loss to Morocco that he would take some time to rest before starting talks with the federation about his future. He said he would have liked to stay with the national team "forever," but knew that it might not be pos-

India lost to Bangladesh by five runs in the second ODI in Mirpur on Wednesday to concede the series 0-2 after having suffered a one-wicket defeat in the first ODI.

"Definitely the Indian team is not going in the right direction. I have not seen the intensity in the team off late. I have not seen 'Josh' in them in the last couple of years," Lal said.
"They are not looking like

an Indian team at all. That passion of playing for the country is missing. Either their bodies are too tired or they are just going through the motions. And this is a serious concern."

Deepak Chahar, who has been bothered by injuries this year, couldn't complete his quota of overs during the second ODI. The Indian players

are dealing with fitness issues with star pacer Jasprit Bumrah and all-rounder Ravindra Jadeja too out of the team

owing to injuries. Highlighting fitness issue of players, skipper Rohit Sharma on Wednesday said that India "can't have guys coming in to play for the country half-fit."

Referring to Rohit's observation, Lal, who is a member of the 1983 World Cup winning team, said: "It is a very sad thing. If the captain is saying this then something is wrong somewhere."

"Who is responsible for this? Are trainers responsible for this? Why are unfit players going? You are playing international cricket and the result is in front of you.

"If they want to take rest they can take rest during IPL matches. Your country comes first. If you are not going to win ICC trophies, your nation's cricket is going to go down."

Marnus Labuschagne and Travis Head posted unbeaten centuries in a 199-run stand to lead Australia to 330-3 against West Indies at stumps on day one Thursday of the second cricket Test. Labuschagne scored his third century in as many innings against West Indies and was 120 not out at Adelaide Oval.

Head was 114 not out after making his first test century on his home ground in the daynight match.

Both teams made injuryenforced changes following Australia's 164-run win in the series-opener in Perth last weekend. Marquino Mindley, one of three changes for the depleted West Indies, left the field with a hamstring strain after bowling just two overs on debut.

The Australians got on top early after stand-in captain Steve Smith won the toss and opted to bat first. Usman Khawaia shared a 34-run opening stand with David Warner (21) and 95 with Labuschagne for the second wicket before his dismissal for 62 triggered the only slight wobble in Australia's innings.

Part-time seamer Devon Thomas was the unlikely bowler to break the second-wicket

stand, trapping Khawaja lbw first ball of the 42nd over. Khawaja was given out and

immediately reviewed the decision, but the third umpire confirmed the dismissal and Australia was 129-2. In the next over, former

skipper Jason Holder took a return catch off his own bowling to dismiss Smith for a duck as Australia lost two wickets for two runs in 11 deliveries.

But Labuschagne and Head counter-attacked in quick time, restoring Australia's dominance. Labuschagne cut Thomas to

the point boundary to raise his 10th century in his 30th test, and third in succession in this series following his 204 and 104 not out in Perth.

Wood for 2nd Test

England brought in fast bowler Mark Wood and shrugged off Pakistan's attempt to make the Multan pitch friendlier for spin in the second Test from Friday.

Wood was the only change England made after its landmark, 74-run win in the first Test at Rawalpindi on Monday.

Wood replaced allrounder Liam Livingstone, who returned home after injuring his knee during the first Test. "Having someone in your squad who can bowl at 150 kph is a

massive bonus for any team," England captain Ben Stokes said of Wood on Thursday. "Having someone of this

caliber and what he brings, the way in which he bowls, is going to be massive for us. He is going to add to our ability to take 20 wickets?

Wood hasn't played a test since March when he sustained an elbow injury. He missed the entire English county season and returned to international cricket during England's sevenmatch T20 series in Pakistan in September. But a hip injury sidelined him from the climax



of the triumphant T20 World Cup campaign in Australia. Ollie Pope was retained

behind the wickets after replacing an ill Ben Foakes for the first Test. Pope scored a century and made six catches and a stumping. Stokes stressed Foakes remained their prime glovesman but at the moment Pope's role as a batter and wicketkeeper perfectly suited the team combination. "The performance that Popey put in was outstanding," Stokes said. "To stand behind the stumps for the amount of time that he did after scoring a hundred and then

standing in the field . . . Especially as someone who's not used to doing that role." With Shaheen Afridi inju-

red and out of the entire threematch series, Pakistan's bowling resources were further depleted when paceman Haris Rauf was ruled out of the remaining two Tests after injuring his right thigh during his debut Test at Rawalpindi.

'We are facing injury problems because most of our fast bowlers are playing in all the three formats and that is very tough on them," Pakistan captain Babar Azam said.
