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Rijiju slams judiciary for Rahul tries to deflect publicising IB, RAW files Digvijaya's self-goal

It's a matter of grave concern, with implications, I will react at appropriate time, says Law Min

Continuing his campaign against the judiciary, Law Minister Kiren Rijiju on Tuesday said it was a "matter of grave concern" that the Supreme Court Collegium put in public domain certain portions of sensitive reports of the Intelligence Bureau (IB) and the Research and Analysis Wing (RAW) while reiterating the apex court's recommendation for elevation of five advocates as High Court Judges. Addressing a press conference at his Ministry's function on e-courts, Rijiju said Intelligence agency officials work in a secret manner for the nation, and they would "think twice" in future if their reports are made public, and making their reports public "will have

an implication."
"Putting the sensitive or secret reports of the RAW and

IB in public domain is a matter of grave concern on which I will react at an appropriate time. Today is not the appropriate time," Rijiju told reporters amid a volley of questions in this regard.

This is for the first time that the Government has reacted to portions of these reports that were put in public domain by the Supreme Court he said. Rijiju also referred to

Collegiums. Asked whether he would 'sensitise' Chief Justice of India (CJI) DY Chandrachud in this regard, the Law Minister said he often meets the CII. We are always in touch. He is the head of the judiciary, and I am the bridge between the Government and the judiciary so we have to work together. You cannot work in isolation,

certain statements and tweets by politicians and lawyers slamming him for lowering the dignity of the top court by commenting on the Collegium. He said while appointments are an administrative issue, judicial pronouncements are "totally

"I am not commenting, or nobody should make any kind of comment when it is a judicial order. Some people may say that certain remarks are made which compromise the independence of the judiciary. So let us be very clear. When we are talking about the appointment process — this is an administrative matter. This has nothing to do with judicial order or pronouncement," he said

Meanwhile, noted lawyer and former Law Minister Kapil Sibal condemned Rijiju's speech on Monday in which the Law Minister had said that though judges are not elected by people but they should bear in mind that people are watching their verdicts in this age of social media. "Are all your controversial statements meant to strengthen the judiciary? You might believe it. We lawyers don't," said Sibal.

The Supreme Court Collegium on January 19, reiterated its recommendation for appointing five judges, rejecting the intelligence agencies reports against them.

The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has imposed a penalty of ₹10 lakh on Air India for not reporting on time against two unruly passengers on a Paris-Delhi flight (AI-142) of December 6, 2022.

According to the DGCA apart from not reporting the incident on time, the airline also delayed referring the matter to its Internal Committee. This is the second time in less than a week that the DGCA has taken enforcement action against the airline in connec tion with unruly passenger behaviour.

Meanwhile Air India on Tuesday said it has closed the internal probe into the urination case and will assist the flight's Pilot-in-Command with an appeal against the suspension of his licence by DGCA.

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
'Pathaan' sets advance booking record

CFSL to conduct narco & polygraph tests of Pulkit Arya in February first week

Science Laboratory (CFSL) is likely to conduct narco and polygraph tests of Pulkit Arva, the main accused in the Ankita Bhandari murder case, in the first week of February after the recent court order. The additional director general (ADG) of police (Law and Order) V Murugesan said that the authority has presently given dates from February 1 to 3 to conduct narco and polygraph tests as per the court order but changes are possible in this schedule too due to certain factors. However, he added that the tests are most likely to be conducted in the first week of February.

The body of 19-year-old receptionist Ankita Bhandari from Pauri Garhwal was recovered from the Chilla canal in Rishikesh on September 24 last year. The police arrested the main accused Pulkit Arva- the owner of Vanantara Resort and his two accomplices Ankit

The team of Central Gupta and Saurabh Bhaskar Science on September 23.

The Special Investigation Team (SİT) investigating the case also later added charges of sexual harassment under section 354A of IPC and Section 5 under the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act against them along with the charges of murder (IPC 302), criminal conspiracy (IPC 120B) and concealment of evidence (IPC 201) sections on October 9.

The police also invoked Gangster Act against the three accused in the case on October 30. The SIT filed a chargesheet of 500 pages against the three accused last month based on about 100 witnesses and 30 pieces of concrete evidence in this case. Doon police arrest vlogger for traffic violation and insulting women's modesty for views

The Dehradun police have arrested a vlogger Dhananjay Singh, a Patelnagar resident, for rash driving and allegedly insulting women's modesty on roads in order to garner views on social media platforms. The superintendent of police, traffic, Akshay Konde said that the accused has uploaded many videos in social media where he can be seen causing inconvenience to the public, especially young women. "He has uploaded several videos with titles like 'Cute girl reaction on Kawasaki Z900' and 'Cute girl market reaction' on social media.

In such videos, he can be seen unnecessarily accelerating the accelerator of his bike to seek the attention of young women and subsequently passing from in front of them

slowly. He then uploads such videos with absurd titles. It is clearly visible in his videos that such stunts caused inconvenience to those women.

He has also uploaded videos of rash driving in narrow lanes and colonies causing inconvenience to local residents," said Konde. He said that considering all such violations, the police registered an FIR against him and arrested him on Monday evening. The police have imposed section 177 (false information), section 290 (punishment for public nuisance in cases not otherwise provided for), section 509 - (word, gesture or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman) and section 283 (danger or obstruction in public way or navigation path) under Indian Penal Code.

Rs 3.72 crore distributed to 301 affected families as interim relief in Joshimath

Helping affected people akin to serving humanity, says CM

PNS DEHRADUN

The Disaster Management secretary Ranjit Kumar Sinha said that an amount of Rs 3.72 crore has been distributed to 301 affected families as interim relief in Joshimath so far. He said that the initial discharge of water in Joshimath which was 540 litres per minute (LPM) on January 6 has reduced to 182 LPM at present. Meanwhile chief minister Pushkar Singh Dhami said that helping the affecting people at this time is serving humanity.

Sinha said that in the temporary relief camps, Joshimath has a total of 661 rooms with a capacity of 2,957 people and Pipalkot has 491 rooms with a capacity of 2,05 people. Till now ity of 2,205 people. Till now cracks have been reported in 863 buildings. Further, 947 members of 282 famidisplaced in view of security.

Meanwhile, Emaar India CEO Kalyan Chakrabarti met chief minister Pushkar Singh Dhami and said that his company will construct upto 150 pre fabricated huts for the affected people of Joshimath. Appealing all to become involved in assisting the affected people of Joshimath, Dhami said that helping people in such a situation is service to humanity. However, the US said it is familiar with the shared values that connect Washington and New Delhi as two thriving and vibrant democracies

Responding to questions raised by a Pakistani journalist, State Department Spokesperson Ned Price on late Monday told reporters that Washington shares an "exceptionally deep partnership" with New Delhi based on values that are common to both the US and Indian democracies.

When the journalist pressed further on the BBC documentary, Price said: "I'm not familiar with the (BBC) documentary (on 2002 Gujarat riots) you're referring to. Í am very familiar with the shared values that connect the United States and India as two thriving, vibrant democracies.

"When we have concerns about actions that are taken in India, we've voiced those. We've had an occasion to do that. But we want first and foremost to reinforce those values that are at the heart of our relationship,' Price said, with the Biden



Administration, like the British Government, distancing itself from such a documentary. Price said there are several elements that bolster Washington's global strategic partnership with New Delhi, which include political, economic and through people-to-people ties.

'What I will say broadly is that there are a number of elements that undergird the global strategic partnership that we have with our Indian partners. There are close political ties. There are economic ties. There are exceptionally deep peopleto-people ties between the US and India," he added.

But one of those additional elements are the values that we share, the values that are common to American democracy and to Indian democracy.

India, of course, is the world's largest democracy. It's a vibrant democracy. And again, we look to everything that ties us together, and we look to reinforce all of those elements that tie us together," Price told reporters at his daily news conference. The Indian government has condemned the BBC's

controversial documentary, which has not been screened in India, as a "propaganda piece" with a questionable agenda

'We think that this is a propaganda piece, designed to push a particular discredited narrative. The bias, lack of objectivity and continuing colonial mindset is blatantly visible," Ministry of External Affairs(MEA) spokesperson Arindam Bagchi said last week.

Last week, British Prime

Minister Rishi Sunak defended Prime Minister Modi over the BBC documentary, asserting that he "did not agree with the characterisation" of his Indian counterpart. Several members of the Indian diaspora in the UK have sent complaints to the BBC over the characterisation of the Indian leader in the series. Meanwhile, the US has reaf-

firmed that the pace, the scope and the character of any dialogue between India and Pakistan is a matter for the two countries, asserting that Washington has always supported talks between the two neighbours to ensure peace in South Asia.

Responding to a question raised by a Pakistani journalist on Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif's recent remarks seeking peace talks with India. Price said even though the United States wants to see regional stability in South Asia, its relationships with Pakistan and India "stand

Prasad raps Rahul for dismissing Digvijaya's comment on surgical strikes as his personal opinion

Claiming that Rahul Gandhi's 'Bharat Jodo Yatra' is turning out to be a "Bharat todo yatra, the BJP on Tuesday slammed the former Congress president for dismissing his party colleague Digvijaya Singh's controversial comments on surgical strikes as his "personal opinion" and asked the Opposition party to make its stand clear on the issues of terrorism and national security.

Latching on to former Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister's Digvijaya Singh for raising questions on surgical strikes during the ongoing 'Bharat Jodo yatra' passing by Jammu & Kashmir, the BJP alleged that Congress has been "disrespectful' to the armed forces and been making "insulting" remarks against them in the past.

Addressing a press conference here senior BJP leader and former Union Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad asked as why Rahul could not convince Digvijaya who he said been with him since the beginning of the 'Yatra' from Kanya Kumari his party's view on the issue and "Why did Rahul Gandhi take so long to publicly declare his respect for the armed forces".

"Rahul Gandhi ji, even after walking thousands of kilometers with you, why couldn't you teach Digvijaya Singh to respect the Army?



Congress leader Rahul Gandhi during the Bharat Jodo Yatra, in Nagrota, on

This is not the first time he (Singh) has spoken against the Army. This time he did it in Kashmir, it is a matter of great shame," said BJP leader. He lashed-out at Rahul for dismissing Digvijaya Singh's controversial comments on surgical strikes as his "personal opinion".

Referring to former Chief Minister raising questions on surgical strikes, Prasad said the 'Bharat Jodo Yatra' of which Digvijaya Singh is also a coorganizer "is turning-out to be a 'Bharat todo yatra' The BJP

leader also asked the Congress to make its stand clear on the issues of terrorism and national security. Prasad said the Congress has a habit of projecting uncomfortable views of its leaders as their personal views and asked if there is any limit to such opinion.

"The question is what is the standard of these leaders when it comes to respecting our armed forces. Indians do not seek proof of their heroics but salute them," Prasad told reporters, noting that Singh has a history of taking controver-

sial stands, be it visiting families of suspected terrorists killed in the Batla House encounter or praising radical Islamic preach-

Attacking Gandhi for his "vacillating" stand on armed forces, he also cited some of his previous remarks, including a recent comment in Dausa during the 'Bharat Jodo Yatra' questioning the government's handling of the border standoff with China and claim that the Chinese were "beating up" Indian soldiers. He had used the "khoon ki

dalali" barb after the 2016 surgical strikes to attack the Modi government and gone to the Jawaharlal Nehru University to extend moral support to "tukde tukde gang", Prasad said.

Why it took him so many years to say publicly that he respects armed forces, the BJP leader asked. He should have also said "sorry" for what he had said earlier, Prasad added.

He also took a swipe at the Congress for questioning the BJP's credibility on the press freedom and questioned Congress General Secretary in-charge of Communications, Publicity and Media Jairam Ramesh for physically preventing a journalist from asking questions to Singh on his statement about the surgical strikes and the 2019 Pulwama terror attack in which 40 CRPF personnel were killed.

Rahul on Tuesday said he and the Congress do not agree with Singh's comments on sur-

gical strikes and that the armed forces do not need to give any proof. Meanwhile, amid a controversy over Digvijava Singh's comments on surgical strikes, another BJP leader and Union Law Minister Kiren Rijiju shared a video of retired Air Marshal Raghunath Nambiar stating that the Balakot air strike was a "thumping success". Sharing the video clip on Twitter, Rijiju said, "This is the reply to Congress party and all those who question the Indian Armed Forces.'

In the video, Nambiar, who retired as Air Officer Commanding-in-Chief of the Western Command of the Indian Air Force in 2019, said the pilots who carried out the air strike at Balakot achieved "all objectives" that had been

This gentleman does not know what he is talking about... I took over as the Commanderin-Chief of the Western Air Command two days after the Balakot air strike, and I am fully aware of what transpired," the retired Air Marshal said, referring to Singh.

"Let me assure you our brave pilots did exactly as they were briefed and achieved all objectives we had set for them. Please do not believe any lie, and rest assured Balakot air strike was a thumping success, he said.

The Balakot air strike was carried out in response to the Pulwama terror attack in which 40 CRPF personnel were killed



MD of Manipur-based firm held in Ponzi-linked money laundering case

New Delhi: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has arrested the Managing Director of a Manipur-based company in a money laundering case linked to a Ponzi scheme through which 15,000 investors were duped of their investments to the tune of Rs 580 crore.

The ED conducted searches at eight different locations of Lamjingba Group of companies and its MD Sanasam Jacky Singh in Gurugram (Haryana), Kolkata (West Bengal) Manipur in the money laundering case and recovered Rs 34 lakh cash and various incriminating documents such as copies of property documents, list of investors, details of funds collected from the investors and foreign invest-

ments, the agency said in a statement. The ED arrested Singh on Saturday and a court later sent him to ED custody. The money laundering probe relates to a "large-scale Ponzi

scheme operated by Sanasam Jacky Singh...," it said. "These incriminating doc-uments are related to generation of proceeds of crime, its further diversion, transfer and end use by the accused Sanasam Jacky Singh and others," it said.

Two bank accounts of Singh, with a balance amount of Rs 1,34,01,989, were also frozen. Further, four immovable properties (commercial buildings/lands) situated in Gurugram and Imphal, were also frozen/seized.

WHO for action to protect kids from spurious medicines

oncerned at the reports of Udeath among children due to cough syrups and medicines in some countries, the World Health Organisation (WHO) has issued an "urgent call to action" to the members to detect and respond to incidents of falsified medical products and protect children from contaminated medicines.

The global health agency said that over the past four months, countries reported several incidents of over-thecounter (OTC) cough syrups for children with confirmed or suspected contamination with high levels of diethylene glycol (DEG) and ethylene glycol (EG). The cases are from at

least seven countries, associated with more than 300 fatalities in three of these countries, with most young children under the age of five. The WHO said the contaminants are toxic chemicals used as industrial solvents and antifreeze agents that can be fatal even in small amounts, and should never be found in medicines. "WHO is releasing an

urgent call to action to countries to prevent, detect and respond to incidents of substandard and falsified medical products," the global health agency said. Since October last year, the WHO has issued three global medical alerts over substandard paediatric medicines and syrups.

In October 2022, it issued

an alert over Promethazine Oral Solution, Kofexmalin Baby Cough Syrup, Makoff Baby Cough Syrup and Magrip N Cold Syrup manufactured by Maiden Pharmaceuticals Limited, Haryana, India.

The four "substandard products" were identified in the Gambia and reported to the WHO in September 2022, then in November, an alert was issued by the health agency over eight products, including Unibebi Cough Syrup, Unibebi Demam Paracetamol Demam Paracetamol Syrup identified Paracetamol Syrup, identified in Indonesia and manufac-tured by PT Afi Farma.

Earlier this month, the WHO issued an alert to warn against the use of two "substandard" cough syrups manIndia that have been linked to the deaths of 18 children in Uzbekistan. Ambronol syrup and

ufactured by Marion Biotech,

DOK-1 Max syrup were manufactured by Marion Biotech, based in Noida, Uttar Pradesh. The global health organisation issued the alert saying the svrups fail to meet quality standards and contain contaminants that can prove fatal. The WHO's medical product alerts were rapidly disseminated to the national health authorities of all 194 WHO Member States.

These medical product alerts requested the detection and removal of contaminated medicines from circulation in the markets; increased surveillance and diligence within the

supply chains of countries and regions likely to be affected; immediate notification to WHO if these substandard products are discovered incountry; and otherwise inform the public of the dangers and toxic effects of the substandard medicines at issue. It noted that since these are not isolated incidents, the

WHO called on regulators and governments to detect and remove from circulation in their respective markets any substandard medical products that have been identified in the alerts as potential causes of death and disease; ensure that all medical products in their respective markets are approved for sale by competent authorities and obtainable from authorised/licensed suppliers.



Rahul Gandhi has done well by dissociating the party from Singh's comments on surgical strikes

enior Congress leader and former Madhya Pradesh chief minister Digvijaya Singh seems to relish being in news—even if that harms his own party. His recent statement there is no proof of surgical strikes exemplifies his penchant for attracting attention. Rahul Gandhi did the sensible thing by dissociating the party from Singh's comments. Gandhi unequivocally said that Congress leaders "disagree with Digvijaya Singh's views." He went on to say that the armed forces do their "job exceptionally well. They don't need to be providing proof." The grand old party would like to believe that Gandhi's statement would bring a closure to the issue. But the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), which on Monday had condemned Singh for questioning the 2016 sur-



gical strike, is unlikely to let his recent remarks be buried. It has already said that he "echoes Pakistan's narrative" on the Pulwama terror attack which killed 40 CRPF personnel in 2019. It will keep raking up his remarks. Worse, Singh himself is likely to come up with statements that the BJP loves to denounce. For how Rahul Gandhi would keep disagreeing with Singh's intemperate statements is a question that the party top brass must deliberate on. Perhaps Singh says such things to make headlines; perhaps his politics of championing the cause of Muslims has resulted in a temperament that triggers such remarks; it is, however, the GOP that gets hurt. Championing the cause of Muslims—which usually meant pandering

to the most retrograde sections of the community, and which the BJP rightly calls Muslim appeasement—was a winning proposition in the pro-Modi era. Many a political career was made just by mouthing the fashionable, 'secular' homilies.

Intellectual elites, most of them of Left-liberal disposition, were quite accommodating towards politicians whose 'secular credentials' were impeccable. So, Lalu Prasad Yadav got considerable traction despite serious charges of corruption against him and the withering away of the administration in Bihar under his watch. Digvijaya Singh flourished in that era. He called the Batla House encounter on September 19, 2008, at Jamia Nagar in Delhi "fake." This was despite the fact that in that encounter an ace Delhi Police officer was killed and the Delhi Police was under his own party's government. In 2016, he repeated his demand for a judicial probe into the encounter. Other Congress leaders have also played the same game. In 2012, for instance, the then law minister Salman Khurshid said Congress president Sonia Gandhi "wept bitterly" when she came to know about the young Muslim boys killed in the encounter. The BJP correctly called Khurshid's statement as a "communal ploy to get Muslim votes." That was then. The dynamics of politics were conducive for such ploys. But that politics is well past its expiry date. The sooner Singh recognises this fact, the better for his party.

Don't intervene

Thousands of tech employees are being laid off every day, but Govt intervention is not needed

hese are bad days for tech employees. A layoffs tracking site reported last week that, on an average, over 1.600 tech employees were being given the pink slip every day this month. On Monday, the website came up with something even worse: the number had gone up to 3,000. The situation got exacerbated because Big Tech icons like Microsoft and Google also began retrenching employees. In the last calendar year, more than 1,000 companies reportedly laid off 154,336 workers. There is turmoil among tech workers. It is also evident from the increasing popularity of LinkedIn, a business and employment-focused social media platform. In 2022, it was downloaded 58.4 million times all over the world. Unsurprisingly, LinkedIn is brimming with job searches, help and counsel from friends to their retrenched friends, etc. Thankfully, the Government has not shown any intention of coercing or coax-



ing tech majors to go slow on layoffs. In November, of course, Information Technology Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw had slammed Elon Musk's decision to sack Twitter employees in India: "We condemn the way Twitter has sacked employees in India," said Vaishnaw, adding that the employees "should have given the employees a fair time for transition." But then liberals and the mainstream media love to criticise Musk for his unforgivable 'crime' of being a free speech "absolutist." The Honourable Minister might have been trying to be fashionable when he condemned Musk.

Over a month later, Minister of State for Information Technology Rajeev Chandrasekhar also talked

about retrenchment in the IT sector, but his views were rational and balanced. He said that while the Government "probably cannot" intervene to stop layoffs in the IT sector, it was working to ensure these job losses are "soft landings." He rightly pointed out that there are enough jobs for talented people. He also talked about a Rs 460crore "reskilling" plan. That's the correct approach; the Government can help the sector, and employees in it, by providing indirect support, one of which is reskilling. It should avoid a ham-handed approach, involving diktats to the top brass of IT majors. That may win the Government brownie points in the political arena, but would do no good to either the sector or, in the long run, to the people working there. So far, the Government has avoided such a populist stance. Hopefully, it will stay the course.

Thai Military Generals have managed to subvert civil rule by manipulating the democratic process

hailand, the favorite destination for Indian tourists, is an instructive case for the study of civil-military relations. Control of the military by civil authority, the accepted democratic norm, is frequently challenged by the Palace, the third player even though monar-chy is constitutional. An election is around the corner on 7 May with the parliamentary term ending on 23 March. Currently, a coalition led by the Palang Pracharath Party (PPRP) the military which includes three Generals, all former Army Chiefs, has ruled the country since 2014. The two Generals in subordinate political positions are senior to the Prime Minister. The billionaire PM Thaksin Shinawatra, who was ousted in a military coup in 2006, was followed by his sister Yingluck becoming Prime Minister later and now his daughter Paetongtarn is carrying the flag of Pheu Thai Party (PTP). King Maha Vajiralongkorn, Rama X, barred his elder sister, who renounced royalty, from contesting elections with Thaksin's PTP. Shinawatra according to a report in The Bangkok Post in May 2005 had made arrangements with the Palace to control the Generals. The PPRP is led by Deputy

Prime Minister, Pravit Wongsuwon, the senior most General; Gen Prayut Chan-o-cha juniormost General is PM with Interior Minister Gen Anupong Paochinda. Wongsuwon last month told reporters that his party will decide whether he will be PM but he prefers "military life to political one". He was confident his party would remain in power as part of a coalition. The Sunday China Morning Post of December 2022 reported that three of four Thais think PTP should be in power and Paetongtarn was the favorite leader to end the decade-old military rule. The National Institute of Development Administration polls showed she was 10 percentage points ahead of Prayuth and PTP ahead of PPRP and other political parties. But unless all arties unite against the Generals' PPRP they have no chance of defeating them.



FIRST COLUMN EDUCATION REFORM IS THE NEED OF THE HOUR

Education must help maintain harmony in society

f we look at the current global political scenario, we would easily realize the fact that the demand for harmony between various communities, castes and regional, linguistic and other inter-caste groups is on the top of every nation's agenda.

But the struggle and ideas of nationalism of Netaji have been limited to a paragraph in history textbooks

n September 12, 1944, from somewhere in Burma, a speech echoed and resonated in the minds of every Indian then and even till today. Netaji, in his revolutionary tone, commented: "We have resolved to create a united and free India, therefore, we shall oppose all attempts to divide her and cut her into bits."

And after almost 78 years, a statue of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose was installed at the historic India Gate and the path leading to India Gate has been recently named as the 'Kartavya Path'. The path not only camouflages the iconic Subhas Chandra Bose and his vision of modern India, but also instils in the minds of every Indian, the primary duty to uphold the democratic principles incorporated in the legislature, the executive and the judiciary. It also ignites the spirit among the countrymen that India should always be united and dream of living in a free India and in the process, dedicate their lives in the establishment of India as a country that the entire globe views as a symbol of patriotism and unity in diversity.

The sense of nationalism that Netaji bore in his heart since his childhood and the activities that he carried on for the territory of India till his last breath, make him an iconic statesman.

Netaji, since his young age, was a socially conscious individual and during his days in the Presidency College in Kolkata. He was disturbed by the poverty and hardship that were faced by the people then. It was his sense of equality for all individuals that even made him question his stay at a three storied residence when he saw many beggars not having a roof over their head. And that made him even question the system of governance that created luxuries for a few but poverty for many.

That was his sense of nationalism for India that he envisioned even before India acquired her independence from the colonial rule. Nationalism for Bose was a transparent story of freedom for every individual where no one was dominated, and each and every individual had the equal amount of respect and liberty without any power expressing authority over them. National Security Advisor of India Ajit Doval, in one of his speeches relating to Bose, stated that the British left India not because of Mahatma Gandhi, but because of the rise in nationalism and the spark Netaji created among the soldiers of Indian Army in the form of INA. Such was the aura of INA that even prompted the deeply loyal British Indian Army, Navy and Air Force to join hands in the fervour and energy that was unleashed by

The impact of Netaji leading the Indian National Army was so strong that it not only acted as an opposite Indian force against the British, to which the Indian National Congress and the Muslim League had fallen prey, but it also led to the British wanting his immediate detention.

A visionary ahead of his time, Netaji was not only successful in raising the notion of Nation over community, religion and tribe but he also clearly understood the concept of diplomacy and foreign relations and he rightly applied the 'Chanakya Neeti' that speaks of "Enemy of an enemy is your friend, and this principle helped him to form alliance with Germany and Italy, against the British and as a result of which he was successful in strengthening

the concept of military force in India in the form of INA.

A pragmatic nationalist who respected divergent approaches and views, Netaji understood the soul of the Indian nation and as such, he envisioned a strong central government with a large amount of autonomy allowed to the minority communities and the provinces. Therefore, for these reasons, Netaji's birthday in India, recently has also been tagged as 'Parakram Diwas'.

Netaji's idea of nationalism revolved around the concepts of equality, liberty and justice, individual freedom and balance of power and more importantly his nationalism for India laid in the concept of establishing India as a nation with complete overhauling and recasting of the stereotypical mode of existence, leading to genuine national solidarity that would in the longer run, give India the position of glory. He also believed that a Nation has no right to exist if it has no ambition, but he also emphasised on the fact that progress of a country should be broader and for the community as a whole rather than for fulfilling selfish ends.

But the struggle and ideas of nationalism of Netaji have been limited to a paragraph in history

Third Front again! Before every Lok Sabha poll, the Third Front idea is floated, and the 2024 polls are no exception. Political pundits predict that there is space for the entire Opposition against Bharatiya Janata Party but not a Third Front, as it will splinter the anti-BJP votes and help the ruling dispensation. The concept was tried and tested in 1977, 1989, and 1996-98, supported by either Congress or the BJP. But they were all

short-lived. Some regional satraps led by Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrashekhar Rao are trying to build a Third Front before the 2024 Lok Sabha polls. It includes some influential regional leaders heading BRS, AAP, CPI-M, Trinamool Congress, and the

a coalition minus Congress to fight the BJP.

Parallelly, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi is also currently on a Bharat Jodo Yatra to unite the Opposition parties. In effect, while Rahul wants to lead the Opposition, regional leaders prefer a front minus Congress.

Many ifs and buts are there for forging a Third Front. Since the 1980s, regional forces like SP, BSP, RJD, and JD(U) have emerged and had a stronghold in their respective states. Whether these leaders would come together to challenge Prime Minister Narendra Modi is the milliondollar question. Moreover, historically, arithmetic has shown the Third Front is only possible with the support of either right direction. He tried to

'Serbia faces global isolation over Kosovo'

7 dead as California mourns 3rd mass killing in 8 days

AP ■ HALF MOON BAY (US)

gunman killed seven people at two agricultural businesses in Northern California, plunging the state into mourning again in the wake of its third mass killing in eight days.

Officers arrested a suspect in Monday's shootings, 67-year-old Chunli Zhao, after they found him in his car in the parking lot of a sheriff's substation, San Mateo County Sheriff Christina Corpus said.

Seven people were found dead and an eighth injured at a farm and another location several miles away, the Sheriff's Office said. Officials believe Zhao worked at one of the facilities and that the victims were workers as well, Corpus said. Officials haven't determined a motive for the shooting.

California is still reeling from an attack on a Lunar New Year celebration in Monterey Park that killed 11 and cast a shadow over an important holiday for many Asian-American communities. Authorities are still seeking a motive for the Saturday shooting.

"For the second time in recent days, California communities are mourning the loss of loved ones in a senseless act



of gun violence," President Joe Biden said Tuesday morning. "Even as we await further details on these shootings, we know the scourge of gun violence across America requires stronger

About two hours later, a sheriff's deputy spotted Zhao's car parked outside a sheriff's substation in a strip mall and arrested him.

A video of the arrest showed three officers approaching a parked car with drawn weapons. Zhao got out of the car, and the officers pulled him to the ground, put him in handcuffs, and led him away. A weapon was found in his vehicle, officials said. The video was captured by Kati McHugh, a Half Moon Bay resident who witnessed the

The sheriff's department believes Zhao acted alone.

"We're still trying to understand exactly what happened and why, but it's just incredibly, incredibly tragic," said state Sen. Josh Becker, who represents the area and called it "a very closeknit" agricultural community.

Aerial television images showed police officers collecting evidence from a farm with dozens of greenhouses.



5.9-magnitude earthquake A jolted Western Nepal on Tuesday, killing one person and damaging a number of houses in the region, officials said.

The earthquake, with epicentre in the Mela area of Bajura district in Sudurpaschim province, hit the region at 2:43 PM local time, said Lok Bijaya Adhikari, head of the Earthquake Measurement and Research Centre.

A 35-year-old woman was killed in Gaumul Rural Municipality-2 when a falling rock hit her while she was cutting grass in the nearby forest,

According to provincial police chief, the earthquake damaged a number of houses in Bajura and Bajhang districts. Two houses were destroyed

in Ward No. 7 and two other houses in Ward No. 9 of Badimalika Municipality of Bajura district, which is situated 450-km West of Kathmandu. A temple in the municipality also developed cracks, police

A landslide triggered by the earthquake resulted in the death of over 40 sheep, the police said, adding that one person was injured in the incident.

Remains of 60 of Nepal crash victims handed over to relatives **AP** ■ KATHMANDU

Authorities in Nepal have handed to relatives the bodies of 60 of the 72 people killed in a plane crash last week, the airline said. Rescuers were still searching for two bodies at the site where a Yeti Airlines flight with 72 on board crashed on Jan. 15 at the resort town of Pokhara, 200 kilometers (125 miles) west of the capital, Kathmandu.

Among the 10 other bodies recovered, six have been identified and will be returned to relatives soon and four others still need to be identified, the airline said in a statement late Monday.

The twin-engine ATR 72-500 aircraft plummeted into a gorge as it was approaching Pokhara International Airport in the Himalayan foothills. The crash site is ábout 1.6 kilometers (1 mile) from the runway at an elevation of about 820 meters (2,700 feet).

While it's still not clear what caused the crash, some aviation experts say video taken from the ground of the plane's last moments indicated it went into a stall, although it's unclear why. Nepal's Civil Aviation Authority has also said the airport's instrument landing system will not be working until Feb. 26 eight weeks after the airport began operations on Jan. 1.



Tuesday it summoned the Dutch ambassador following a demonstration targeting Islam's holy book, days after a similar protest in Sweden tensed relations. Edwin Wagensveld, Dutch leader of the far-right Pegida movement in the Netherlands, on Sunday tore pages out of a copy of the Quran near the Dutch parliament and stomped on the pages. Police looked on but did not intervene.

"It is about freedom of expression and I think that should be possible in the Netherlands," Wagensveld said in a video posted on the site of Dutch newspaper Algemeen Dagblad. The Turkish foreign ministry said in its statement that it condemned the "vile attack," which it said was proof of Islamophobia, discrimination and xenophobia in Europe.

The ministry told the Dutch ambassador they expected concrete precautions to prevent and not permit similar demonstrations in the future, and that authorities take action against Wagensveld.

VC investment in Indian startups fell 38% in 2022

7 enture capital (VC) investments in Indian startups plunged over 38 per cent in 2022 as economic uncertainty and market volatility affected fundraising and investment activities, GlobalData said on

In a statement, GlobalData said an analysis of its financial deals database reveals that "a total of 1,726 VC funding deals worth \$20.9 billion were announced in India in 2022 compared to 1,715 deals worth \$33.8 billion in 2021."

"The ongoing economic uncertainty and market volatility continue to affect the fundraising and investment activities in India and subsequently VC investment in the country startups suffered a massive year-on-year 38.2 per cent decline in value terms during 2022," the data and analytics company said.

Aurojyoti Bose, lead analyst at GlobalData, said India is a key Asia-Pacific market and stands just next to China in terms of VC funding deals by volume and value.

It is also among the top four markets (the US, the UK, China and India) globally.

India accounted for 5.1 per cent and 6.3 per cent share of global VC funding value and



volume, respectively, in 2022. While the US, the UK and China registered decline in VC

funding deal volume in 2022 compared to the previous year, India stood out as a notable exception and registered 0.6 per

Although India's VC funding deal volume has slightly increased year-on-year, the significant drop in VC funding value seems to be a fallout of growing investor cautiousness over startup valuations. Moreover, volatile market conditions and recession fears seem to have forced many investors to preserve capital. The restrictions on travel and in-person meetings also made it more difficult for VC firms to conduct

The average size of VC funding deals, which stood at \$19.7 million in 2021 fell to \$12.1 million in 2022. The number of VC deals valued more than or equal to \$100 million announced in India stood at 42 in 2022 as compared to 86 during the previous

"The decrease in venture capital investment can also be attributed to the lack of companies that can generate significant returns for investors. This is a common challenge for emerging economies, and India is no exception," Bose added.

GlobalData said historic data may change in case some deals get added to previous months because of a delay in the disclosure of information in the public domain.



INDIA WHITEWASH BLACK CAPS

Rohit Sharma scored his first ODI hundred in three years while Shubman Gill continued his domination with another sublime ton as India completed a clean sweep with a 90-run win over New Zealand in the third match here on Tuesday.

Batters from both sides lit up the dead rubber as 680 runs were scored at the Holkar Stadium

Rohit (101 off 85 balls) got to the three-figure mark for the first time since January 2020 while Gill (112 off 78) scored his fourth ODI hundred to take India to 385 for nine.

Following twin failures, the

New Zealand top-order put up a much better show. Devon Conway (138) stitched crucial partnerships but Shardul Thakur (3/45) and Kuldeep Yadav (3/62) regularly struck to bowl out the Balck Caps for 295 in 41.2

It was India's second consecutive clean sweep, having beaten Sri Lanka last week. After Hardik Pandya (1/37) got rid of Finn Allen (0), Conway shared 106 runs with Henry Nicholls and 78 runs with Daryl Mitchell and 78 runs with Daryl Mitchell (24). In the absence of Mohammed Shami and Mohammed Siraj, the Indian bowlers struggled initially, leaking runs as Conway tonked the ball all around the park.

Shardul, however, managed

to turn the game, as he took back-to-back wickets of Mitchell and Tom Latham (0) in the 26th over. In his next over, Thakur sent Glenn Phillips (5) packing with a cross-seamed delivery.

Umran Malik (1/52) then got Conway as the centurion pulled awkwardly with Rohit doing the rest at midwicket as the match seemed to slip out of New Zealand's grasp.

The spin duo of Kuldeep and Yuzvendra Chahal (2/43)

then cleaned up the tail.

Earlier, Rohit and Gill put up a belligerent 212-run opening stand, sharing 22 fours and 11 sixes between them.

The 26th over saw both Rohit and Gill getting their centuries. Rohit pulled away to deep square to get to his mark and, three balls later, Gill got to the triple-figure mark, his third

in four innings.

New Zealand skipper Tom
Latham used as many as six bowlers and it was his sixth option — spinner Michael Bracewell — who provided the tourists their first breakthrough.

Trying to slog one out of the park, Rohit missed the ball as it kept low and turned to eventually hit the stumps. His wicket was met with a roar by the partisan crowd, welcoming Virat Kohli (36).

A miscued shot in the next over spelt the end of Gill's innings as New Zealand struck twice in quick succession.

Ishan Kishan (17) didn't look too comfortable and took nine balls to open his account. A yes-no with Kohli, who had sprinted halfway, marked the end of the wicketkeeper batter's stay in the middle.

New Zealand were able to bring down the boundaries and sixes and, looking to play a big shot, Kohli couldn't beat Finn Allen at mid-off. Firmly on course for a 400-plus score, India endured a familiar middleorder batting collapse, before Hardik Pandya (54 off 38 balls) provided the final flourish.



Don't understand why Oz isn't playing a tour game in India: Clarke

Former Australia captain Michael Clarke cannot fathom why Pat Cummins' side is not playing practice or tour games ahead of the Border-Gavaskar series, beginning in India on February 9.

Australia will be touring India for the four-Test series, with the opening game scheduled at Nagpur, and Clarke opined that not playing a tour game could have a "significant" impact on the outcome.

"That's the part (not playing tour games) I don't understand,

Clarke was quoted as saying by Big Sports Breakfast on Tuesday. "The no tour game before the first Test in India. I hope I'm proven wrong but I think that is going to be significant." Clarke, who played 115 Tests and scored more than 8,600 runs, added that playing 20-over or 50-over games in India was completely different from competing in the longest format, especially while

"You need a completely dif-ferent plan to what you have (been) playing in Australia, the way you start your innings against spin bowling, the way you play reverse swing, through the Australian summer we didn't see any reverse swing, the games were over in two, three days," he said.

Clarke added that the probability of India playing at least two spinner in the four-Test series could well favour them, given that the Australians are predominantly playing quick

"So reverse swing is going to play a big part (in India), all these batters that walk out and play bowlers bowling 130-140ks - there's every chance India is going to play at least two spinners, so it's a completely different game.'

Australia will likely arrive in India in the middle of next week, giving them around seven days to tune up for the gruelling series, and Clarke felt that wouldn't be enough.

MANDHANA, HARMAN, RENUKA IN ÍCC WOMEN'S ODI TEAM

Three Indian cricketers — Smriti Mandhana, captain Harmanpreet Kaur and pace bowler Renuka Singh — figure in the ICC Women's ODI Team of the Year announced on Tuesday.

Mandhana, who scored a breezy unbeaten 74 against the West Indies Women in a T20 Tri-series match on Monday, has shown remarkable consistency, helping herself to a century and six half-centuries

The left-handed batter scored a fine 123 against the West Indies at the World Cup in New Zealand, with the 26-year-old following it up with a 91 against England at Hove in September and then again smashing 40 and 50 to finish off the year in style.

India skipper Harmanpreet slammed two centuries and five half-centuries during the calendar year, with her unbeaten 143 against England in September the high point.

Pacer Renuka, who made her ODI debut early last year and couldn't break into the India XI during their unsuccessful 50over World Cup campaign in New Zealand, collected 18 wickets from seven games in 2022, with her best of 4/28 coming against Sri Lanka in Pallekele in the middle of the

Smriti Mandhana and captain Harmanpreet Kaur cracked fine unbeaten half-centuries as India defeated West Indies by 56 runs to keep their slate clean in the Women's T20I Tri-Series

India, after winning the toss and electing to bat, were off to a good start and managed 167 for two in 20 overs. They then restricted the opponents to 111 for four to eke out their second consecutive win of the series.

Openers Yastika Bhatia and Mandhana stitched together a 33-run partnership before the former was dismissed by offspinner Karishma Ramharack for 18 with just one delivery remaining in power play.

Her dismissal brought in

Harleen Deol but her stay at the crease didn't last long, as she was trapped in front while trying to flick the ball on the off-side from pacer Shanika Bruce.

At 52 for two, there were some tense moments but once Mandhana and Harmanpreet paired up, boundaries flowed freely. Harmanpreet, who was back leading the side after missing the opening match of the triseries reportedly due to illness, was on song as she smashed a 35-ball 51 studded with eight boundaries.

Mandhana, after failing with the bat in the opening game against South Africa, was equally belligerent scoring 74 off just 51 deliveries as the duo batted together for nearly 12 overs to guide India to a competitive

Ranji Trophy: Jadeja bowls 17 overs on return; Tamil Nadu 183/4

 $R^{\text{eturning to competitive}}_{\text{cricket after close to six}}$ months, India's premier allrounder Ravindra Jadeja went wicket-less in his 17 overs on a slow Chepauk pitch, as Tamil Nadu made 183/4 against Saurashtra in their Ranji Trophy match here on Tuesday.

In the presence of national selector Sridharan Sharath, who was seen talking to Jadeja after the first day's play, the star leftarm spinner's fitness was put to test ahead of the Australia Test series.

He ended the day with none for 36.

Jadeja is leading Saurashtra in their last group league match with Cheteshwar Pujara and regular captain Jaydev Unadkat rested ahead of the marquee four-match rubber, beginning at Nagpur on February 9.

The all-rounder, who pulled out after injuring his knee during the Asia Cup last September,

for the first two Tests but his inclusion in the 17-man squad is subject to fitness.

Opting to bat, Tamil Nadu lost the wicket of Narayan Jagadeesan in the second over of the day. But thereafter, opener Sai Sudharsan, twins Baba Aparajith and Baba Indrajith steadied the ship with identical scores of 45.

Though Kumar Suraj (22) tried to dig in, Gowtham removed captain Virat Singh (8) and the experienced Saurabh Tiwary (0) in successive balls in the 20th over as Jharkhand slumped to 57 for 4.

Suraj and Kumar Kushagra (37), the top-scorer, put on 29 runs before Gowtham had the former caught by Agarwal.

A 38-run stand for the seventh wicket between Kushagra and Shahbaz Nadeem (22) saved Jharkhand from being bundled out for a low score. Kushagra was one of Gopal's three scalps, caught by Manish Pandey.

Useful contributions from the lower order pushed Jharkhand past the 150-run mark.

In other matches, Kerala, which is aiming to qualify for the knockout phase, had to toil on day 1 against Pondicherry as Paras Dogra's ton helped the team score 253 for 4 in 87 overs while Rajasthan bowled out Services for 178 and replied with 58 for 2 at stumps in a must-win
