# HM talks with netas, janta

Shah promises jobs,  
compensation for riot  
victims, deployment of  
more forces in Manipur

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Tuesday visited Churachandpur, the scene of some of the worst rioting in the recent ethnic conflict which broke out in Manipur earlier this month, and held talks with Kuki civil society leaders. He also held a series of discussions with different Meitei groups, women groups and prominent personalities earlier during the day in Imphal before flying to the headquarters of the hill district by the same name.

Among others, Shah who was accompanied by Intelligence Bureau (IB) chief and Union Home Secretary, met political and social leaders from the Kuki community to understand their grievances and find ways to bring peace to the northeastern state, which has witnessed a series of clashes between Meiteis and Kukis.

He held three rounds of talks with various groups such as Indigenous Tribal Leaders' Forum (ITLF), Kuki Students' Organisation (KSO) and other civil society organisations. He also met five Kuki MLAs from the BJP.

"We demanded total separation from Manipur — both political and geographical. We also sought President's Rule as the law and order has totally collapsed in the State," ITLF secretary Muan Tombing told PTI. The Home Minister on his part, requested the Kuki soci-

ety to maintain peace for the "next 15 days" with an assurance of sending more security personnel for the safety of common people, he added. Asked why Shah mentioned only "15 days", Tombing said, "He told us that the CBI will be entrusted with carrying out a detailed probe to find out the reasons behind this prolonged clash. Besides, a judicial enquiry will also be announced."

Earlier in the day, the Government announced it will provide a compensation of Rs 10 lakh to the next of kin of those who died in the ethnic conflict and a job to a family member. The compensation amount will be borne equally by the Centre and the State, an official release said. The decision was taken at a meeting between the Union Home minister and Chief Minister N Biren Singh in the presence of the Council of Ministers on Monday night.

## Let SC judge-led panel probe riots: Cong to Prez

Top Congress leaders on Tuesday met President Droupadi Murmu and sought her intervention in helping bring normalcy in violence-hit Manipur, and called for the constitution of a high-level enquiry commission headed by a serving or retired Supreme Court judge to probe the incident.

A delegation of Congress leaders led by party Chief Mallikarjun Kharge met the President and handed over a memorandum to her seeking her urgent intervention and handed over a 12-point charter of demands to be taken immediately to help bring peace and normalcy in the



north-eastern State. "Though there were several lapses in the management of the situation at the early stages of violence, leading to the present imbroglio.

Now it is not the time to point fingers, but to act. If the suggestions above are implemented in earnest, peace can perhaps be restored once again.

## CDS: Challenges in Manipur have not disappeared

In the backdrop of tension prevailing in Manipur, Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) General Anil Chauhan on Tuesday said challenges in the State have not disappeared, but expressed hope that things will settle down in some time. He also noted that the situation in the north-eastern State now is not related to insurgency.

These observations by him came as the death toll due to ethnic clashes in Manipur which began on May 3 went up to 80 and Home Minister Amit Shah who is now on a visit to the State held talks with various groups.

The CDS was in Pune on Tuesday to review the passing out parade of 144th course of National Defence Academy (NDA). Asked about situation in Manipur, he told reporters that, "The Army, Assam Rifles were deployed in Manipur before 2020. Since the challenges of northern borders were far more, we were able to withdraw Army. Since insurgency situation had normalised, we were able to do that."

The situation now in Manipur is "not related to insurgency". It is a clash between two ethnicities and a situation of law and order, he said. "We are helping the State Government with the problem," the CDS said.

# UWW hits out at detention of grapplers, threatens WFI ban

Khap, farmer leaders convince wrestlers not to immerse medals in Ganga river

On a drama-filled Tuesday, some of India's best wrestlers accompanied by hundreds of supporters gathered on the banks of the Ganga, threatening to immerse their World and Olympic medals in the holy river but refrained after being convinced by Khap and farmer leaders who sought five days to address their grievances.

Meanwhile, in evidence of growing support to the grapplers the global governing body for wrestling, United World Wrestling (UWW), issued a statement on the grapplers' protest, saying that events of these last days are even more worrying," and the legendary Anil Kumble on Tuesday said he is "dismayed" by the treatment meted out to the protesting wrestlers at Jantar Mantar where they were manhandled and detained by police for trying to march towards the new Parliament building and hold a 'Mahila Mahapanchayat'.

Earlier, Olympic champion shooter Abhinav Bindra, Indian football captain Sunil Chhetri and former India all-



rounder Irfan Pathan too had expressed solidarity with the grapplers. On a day that India's top wrestlers like Rio 2016 bronze medalist Sakshi Malik, Tokyo 2020 medalist Bajrang Punia and world championship medalist Vinesh Phogat almost immersed their medals in the Ganga river, the UWW, came out with a strong statement condemning the "treatment and detention of the wrestlers".

"For several months, United World Wrestling has followed with great concern the situation in India where wrestlers are protesting over allegations of abuse and harassment by the President of the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI)," the statement said before adding: "UWW will request further information about the next elective general assembly from the IOA and the Ad-hoc Committee of the WFI."

The 45-day deadline that was initially set to hold this elective assembly shall be respected. Failing to do so may lead UWW to suspend the federation, thereby forcing

the athletes to compete under a neutral flag. It is reminded that UWW 'already took a measure in this situation by reallocating the Asian Championship planned in New Delhi earlier this year.'

## SKM calls for June 1 nationwide dharna in support of grapplers

**New Delhi:** Farmers' outfit Samyukta Kisan Morcha on Tuesday called for nationwide demonstrations on June 1 in support of wrestlers who have been demanding the arrest of BJP MP and WFI chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, accused of sexually harassing women grapplers.

The Samyukta Kisan Morcha, in a statement, said it has given the call for the nationwide agitation "to secure democratic right to protest by the Indian wrestlers" and all other sections of society and to "demand the arrest of Brij Bhushan Saran Singh". **PTI**

# Delhi girl's killer bought knife 15 days ago: Police

The 20-year-old AC mechanic arrested for his involvement in the horrific Shahbad Dairy murder case purchased the knife used in the killing of 16-year-old girl from Haridwar in Uttarakhand around 15 days ago, said the Delhi Police which is probing the case. Police said on Tuesday that they are yet to recover the knife, adding that Sahil dumped it near Rithala Metro Station after the killing on Sunday evening.

The accused had planned the murder two days ago after the girl rebuffed him in front of her friends and refused to mend her relationship with him, said police. "Since Sahil bought the knife days before the incident, it is not unlikely he was planning to kill her already, yet he is claiming he killed the girl in a fit of rage for her constantly ignoring him, they said. "The statements made by him are being verified since it is the initial stage of investigation. Sometimes he



says she ignored him as he tried to approach her, which angered him. But he also suspected her getting involved with her former boyfriend," the police said.

Earlier, Sahil was produced at Delhi's Rohini court on Tuesday and was sent to police remand for two days.

Police said they will be recreating the scene of crime and will also check Sahil's mobile phone and social media accounts to know whether he was in touch with other girls.

In a related development, the National Commission for Scheduled Castes has sought a report from the Delhi Government and the city police over the horrific killing of a teenage girl in the north-west part of the national Capital.

# Politicos of all hues line up at victim's house, offer solace, compensation

Political parties from the spectrum — the ruling Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), the BJP and the Congress — jostled to seek mileage from the gruesome stabbing case by queuing up at the Shahbad Dairy area to meet with the victim's family members and even making announcements of compensation.

The leaders from BJP, AAP, and Congress met and condoled with the bereaved family members of the 16-year-old girl who was killed in broad daylight in the Shahbad Dairy area of north-west Delhi. Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday announced an ex gratia of Rs 10 lakh to her kin to help them tide over the tragedy while Delhi Women and Child Welfare Minister Atishi met the girl's family members and assured that the Government would ensure that the accused receives the harshest of punishment.

BJP MP Hans Raj Hans also met the girl's family on Tuesday morning and said no amount of money can bring the family its daughter back and also condemned the AAP for "politicising" the murder and using it to score political brownie points.

Delhi Congress president Anil Chaudhary, who also visited the family members of the victim, said, "Blame game begins" between Kejriwal and the L-G every time the "Government is held accountable." Delhi Commission for Women (DCW) Swati Maliwal too met the girl's family. The girl was stabbed over 20 times and bludgeoned to death by a youth in a busy bylane of Shahbad Dairy area as passers-by looked on in fear and disbelief. "The Delhi Government will provide an ex-gratia of Rs 10 lakh to the family of the victim and will try its best to get the culprit punished severely by the court. Best lawyers will be fielded for this case," Kejriwal in a tweet in Hindi announced.

Atishi visited the family of the victim in the Shahabad Dairy murder case and offered her condolences.

# 10 Vaishno pilgrims dead, 66 hurt as bus falls off bridge

Ten Vaishno Devi pilgrims were killed and 66 injured on Tuesday as the bus they were travelling in veered off the road while crossing a bridge near Jhajjar Kotli along the Jammu Srinagar National Highway. The death toll may go up as Government Medical College Hospital Principal Shashi Soodan said two of the injured admitted at the facility are critical.

The officials said the bus, which was on its way to Katra from Amritsar, met with the accident in the Jhajjar Kotli area on the Jammu-Srinagar National Highway between 6.30 and 7 am. Katra is a base camp for the pilgrims visiting the famous shrine atop the Trikuta hills in Reasi district.

They said most of the travellers were members of an extended family from Bihar's Lakhisarai and were on pilgrimage to Vaishno Devi temple for a ritual of a child.

"The accident took place at Jhajjar Kotli bridge. Ten people have died. Rescue operation is almost complete," Jammu Senior Superintendent of Police

Chandan Kohli told PTI. "We are investigating the reasons behind the accident."

Local residents, CRPF and police personnel rushed to the spot and launched the rescue operation.

"The troops of 137 CRPF battalion carried out the rescue operation to evacuate injured driver and passengers from the bus, which turned turtle and fell down from Jhajjar Kotli bridge on highway," the force said in a tweet.

"Two persons were

brought dead while others died on the spot," said GMC hospital principal Soodan.

Jammu and Kashmir DGP Dilbagh Singh said prima facie the cause of accident appeared to be human error or over speeding.

It is possible that the driver might have dozed off on the wheel. It's a high flyover kind of road from where the bus fell off, so the reason could also be overspeeding. It is part of our investigation," he told reporters.

# India's Def exports up 23 times at ₹16K-cr

With the Government giving a push to self-reliance in defence sector, India's defence exports jumped 23 times and have reached an all-time high, surging from Rs. 686 crore in Financial Year(FN) 2013- 14 to nearly Rs 16,000 crore in FY 2022-23. Giving these details here, a Government statement said on Tuesday this remarkable 23-fold increase reflects India's progress in the global defence manufacturing sector. With exports reaching more than 85 countries, India's defence industry has shown its capability of design and development to the

world, with 100 firms exporting defence products at present.

To give a push to defence exports, the Government has taken a number of policy initiatives and brought reforms over the last 9 years. Export procedures have been simplified and made industry-friendly with end-to-end online export authorisation curtailing delays and bringing ease of doing business.

The Atmanirbhar Bharat initiatives have helped the country by encouraging indigenous design, development and manufacture of defence equipment in the country, thereby reducing dependency on imports in the long run.

# Man assaults AI crew member on Goa-Delhi flight

**New Delhi:** A male passenger onboard an Air India (A-I) flight from Goa on Monday physically assaulted a crew member and was handed over to the security personnel after landing at the Delhi airport, according to the airline.

In recent months, there have been multiple incidents of unruly passenger behaviour onboard aircraft and the latest incident happened onboard flight AI882 enroute from Goa to Delhi. "The said passenger verbally abused the crew members and then went on to physically assault one of them on board.

# Purana Qila reveals more of its historic past

## Layers of history peeled as archeologists unearth ancient copper wheel, bone needle, kiln and coins

Historical Purana Qila in the National Capital continues to enthrall archeologists who recently unearthed a range of ancient artifacts such as a spoked copper wheel of Kushana era, an arrowhead of the Rajput period and coins dating from the Mughal reign from the site.

India now plans to showcase this treasure trove of its rich heritage and cultural diversity to foreign delegates during the forthcoming G20 Summit to be held here in September. The fresh round of excavation

which began in late January is being led by archaeologist Vasant Swarnkar. This is the third round of excavations at the 16th Century Purana Qila, after excavations in 2013-14 and 2017-18 revealed nine cul-

tural levels, representing different historical periods, including the pre-Mauryan period, Mauryan, Sunga, Kushana, Gupta, post-Gupta, Rajput, Sultanate, and Mughal period. It is one of "rare archae-

ological sites" in India where layers of history spanning over 2,500 years have been found, Swarnkar said, adding that painted grey wares (PGWs) were found in the first round of excavations in 2013-14.

Union Minister G Kishan Reddy who visited the site on Tuesday morning said, "This is the only site in Delhi-NCR where one can witness the continuous history of Delhi from the pre-Mauryan to Mughal period through the excavated remains. The findings showcase the rich cultural heritage of our country." The ongoing excavation, initiated in January 2023, aims to

establish a complete chronology of site. Currently, structures from the early Kushana level have been exposed, with a depth of 5.50 meters reached thus far. This excavation is expected to provide further insights into the ancient city of Indraprastha.

The excavation has yielded a remarkable collection of artifacts. Notable findings include a stone image of Vaikuntha Vishnu, a terracotta plaque of Gaja Laxmi, a stone image of Ganesha, seals and sealings, coins, terracotta figurines of humans and animals, beads of various stones, TC, and a bone needle.

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# Nijjer out; Balkar Singh and Gurmeet Singh Khudian to be sworn in as new Ministers

Punjab Cabinet reshuffle

Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann's Cabinet is set for another reshuffle of his Council of Ministers, with the state Local Government Minister Dr Inderbir Singh Nijjar tendering his resignation from the Cabinet on personal grounds.

Forwarding the same to Governor Banwarilal Purohit for "early acceptance", the Chief Minister has also proposed the names of Aam Aadmi Party's (AAP) legislators — Balkar Singh from Kartarpur, and Gurmeet Singh Khudian from Lambi — for inducting in his Cabinet.

The exit of Amritsar South MLA Dr Nijjar from the Cabinet came as a surprise and against the speculations that it would be Food and Civil Supplies Minister Lal Chand Kataruchak, facing serious allegations of sexual misconduct, who would put down his papers. Notably, Dr Nijjar was inducted in the Cabinet in July last year, along with four other Ministers.

A spokesperson of the

Chief Minister's Office said that in a communique to the Governor, Bhagwant Mann has impressed upon him to accept the resignation of Dr Nijjar, who has resigned on personal grounds, from Cabinet.

"The Chief Minister has also proposed the names Balkar Singh, MLA Kartarpur, and Gurmeet Singh Khudian, MLA Lambi, for inducting them as Cabinet Ministers. He had requested the Governor to accord kind approval to administer the Oath of Office and Secrecy to the new Ministers at 11 am on May 31 in Punjab Raj Bhawan, Chandigarh," said the spokesperson.

As per the information available, the Raj Bhawan had not received any file from the Government regarding the Cabinet reshuffle till 8 pm, before the Governor called it a day. Thus, the Governor's approval to the resignation and the timings for the oath ceremony of two new ministers will come only after the file will be put before him on Wednesday morning.

"As of now, the time slot of 11 am has been reserved on the Government's request," a government official informed The Pioneer.

Punjab can have 18 minis-

ters, including the Chief Minister. Currently, there are 15 Ministers in the Cabinet, including Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann. After Tuesday's expansion, two posts will still be vacant. In July, Mann carried out the first Cabinet expansion, inducting five Ministers.

The Cabinet reshuffle is being carried out on the day when AAP supreme and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal is also scheduled to be in Chandigarh on Wednesday.

As per reports, the ruling AAP is planning to exhibit its strength, especially at a time when its top leadership is going nationwide to gather support in party-led Delhi Government's fight against the Centre's ordinance.

Chief Minister Mann has invited all the Ministers, party MLAs, along with the parliamentarians from both the House of the Parliament for dinner on Wednesday night, along with their spouses and families, at his official residence. The meeting assumes significance as Kejriwal would be meeting the party leaders for the first time after recently winning the Jalandhar bypoll. By winning the Jalandhar Lok Sabha by-election, AAP has

secured a berth in the Lok Sabha, which has also come as a morale-booster for the party, especially ahead of the ensuing 2024 general elections.

Besides, the dinner diplomacy is also expected to be aimed at apprising the state party leaders about the Ordinance brought in by BJP-led Central Government to gain control over officers in Delhi, besides sharing with them the progress made in its "outreach campaign".

It has been learnt that the AAP, in its attempt to take on board all the non-BJP parties, including the Congress, in fight against the Centre's ordinance, wanted its Punjab leaders to try creating a scope for dialogue with the state Congress unit over the matter, and putting forth its point. Notably, the Punjab Congress unit had strongly asked the party high command not to extend its support to the AAP and Kejriwal over the ordinance row.

As per available information, Kejriwal would be spending a night at Chandigarh before leaving with Bhagwant Mann on Thursday for Tamil Nadu and Odisha to gain support of the DMK and BJD against the Centre's ordinance.

Expressing deep anguish and sorrow over the callous attitude of the Union Government due to which wrestlers have been forced to immerse their medals in Ganga river, Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Tuesday slammed the Narendra Modi led Central Government for ignoring the wrestlers' genuine demands.

"These wrestlers have given their sweat and toil for bringing the medals for the country. It is unfortunate that instead of listening to their demands, the voice of these wrestlers has been muzzled again and again by the Union Government... These wrestlers have been struggling for their legitimate rights but fed up by the Centre's step-motherly treatment, these players have taken the decision to drown their medals," he said.

He said that it would have been very hard for these players to take this decision of immersing their medals which they had won after so much commitment, perseverance, and hard work in field of sports.

Mann said that this is the black day for the sports, sports lovers, and sports fraternity as players have to resort to such steps to get themselves heard.

The Chief Minister said that if the entire country just remains a mute spectator to this unholy acts of the Modi government, "the day is not far when we have to submerge the ashes of democracy in the river".

"The country should unite against the high handedness of the Union Government and rally solidly behind the players," said Mann, adding that it is the need of hour to save the country and strengthen the ethos of democracy in it. Notably, top Indian wrestlers — Sakshi Malik, Vinesh Phogat, and Bajrang Punia — along with hundreds of their supporters, reached Har ki Pauri in Uttarakhand on Tuesday to immerse their medals in the Ganga.

A huge crowd gathered in Har ki Pauri as the protesting wrestlers got ready to immerse their world championship and Olympic medals in the river as a mark of protest against outgoing WFI chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh. They were eventually stopped by prominent farmers' leader Naresh Tikait, who took away their medals, giving a five-day ultimatum to the Centre.

## Punjab CM asks Transport Dept to ensure zero pendency of DL, RC by Jun 15

Aimed at mitigating the woes of the common man, Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Tuesday asked the Transport Department to ensure zero pendency of the Driving License (DL) and Registration Certificate (RC) of vehicles by June 15.

Mann, chairing a meeting of the state Transport Department, underlined the need for providing these services to the people in a time-bound manner. "The people should not face any sort of inconvenience in getting the DLs and RCs issued from the State Government," he said.

He categorically asked the officers to ensure that the backlog of RCs and DLs, which had been pending because of technical reasons, is cleared by June 15 by all means.

"The pendency of printing of smart cards in respect of DL



is almost cleared. On April 8, only 29,934 DLs were printed which was increased to 3,08,061 on May 29... The pendency of printing of DLs has been reduced from 1,77,012 on April 8 to 1,943 on May 29," he noted.

Similarly, the Chief Minister said that printing of RC was nil on April 8 but it was recorded 3,47,272 on May 29. The pendency of printing of smart cards of RC is 56,251 as on May 29 whereas it was 2,26,825 on April 8.

Mann said that in order to avoid problems of printing and

pendency in the future, an undertaking should be taken from the company that the stock of smartcards required for the coming three months would be available with them.

The Chief Minister also said that most of the problems in the issuance of DL are coming as most of the time fee is deposited and the applicant does not come for a photograph or the applicant applies for two categories (Motor Cycle & LMV) but appears for the competence test only for one category.

Likewise, he said that in case of RC non-fitting of high-security registration plates without which RC cannot be approved and non-depositing of complete required government fee or motor vehicle tax is the reason for delay, Mann said, adding that most of time, people do not upload complete documents as required under rules due to which delay occurs adding that applicants must avoid these issues.

## Punjab Taxation Dept to tight noose around tax evaders from service sectors

**With penalty of over Rs 234 cr, SIPU registers 38% increase in total penalty from Goods in Transit**

Punjab Taxation Department will tighten the noose around tax evaders from the service sector. Issuing the directions to the Department on Tuesday, the state Finance, Planning, Excise and Taxation Minister Harpal Singh Cheema asked the State Intelligence and Preventive Unit (SIPU) and Tax Intelligence Unit (TIU) to work in tandem to trace, track, and nab the tax evaders from service sectors.

Cheema, chairing the maiden review meeting of SIPU, said that the Department has performed remarkably in checking tax evasion in the trade of goods, and now the need of the hour is to put a strong check over the tax

evaders in the field of service sectors.

He asked the Department to formulate a strong strategy against those registered and non-registered service providers who were not paying GST for the paid services being rendered by them.

Earlier, the officials apprised the Minister about the goals and achievements of SIPU through a PowerPoint presentation.

The newly-formed SIPU, which was earlier known as mobile wing of the Taxation Department, has 38 per cent increase in total penalty from Goods in Transit by charging a penalty of Rs 190.94 crore and Rs 43.54 crore from inspections during 2022-23 against the total of Rs 169.13 crore during 2021-22. Out of this, a penalty of Rs 121.43 crore was charged only from iron and steel scrap and finished goods, resulting in 66.44 percent of total detention.

The total detentions were 9,018 out of which 2,455 were from Ludhiana only. In most of

the major cases where more than 20 lakh in a single vehicle, the vehicles were carrying copper scrap and edible oil.

In the presentation of the Tax Intelligence Unit, the Minister was apprised that the TIU has reversed the Input Tax Credit (ITC) amounting to Rs 1294.04 crore besides blocking the ITC worth Rs 52.98 crore up to March 31, 2023. This includes ITC reversal of Rs 1,084.95 crore with the inspection of 10 major cases.

The TIU found that some of the life insurance and health assurance firms were claiming and utilizing undue ITC. Cancelled dealers were also scrutinized by the TIU team. During scrutiny, it has been detected that many of these dealers have a huge ITC credit balance in their credit ledger. The cases are still under verification and based on the report of TIU, districts have so far reversed ITC to the tune of Rs 209.08 crore and blocked ITC worth Rs 43.20 crore.

## Integrated Multi-Modal logistics hub and IMC Hisar would immensely benefit Hry: CM

Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Tuesday chaired the second meeting of the apex monitoring authority on the National Industrial Corridor Development and Implementation Trust (NICDIT).

Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar along with the Chief Ministers and Industry Ministers of various states participated in this meeting through video conferencing. During the meeting, Khattar shared the progress report of the two big projects of the state namely the Integrated Multi-Modal logistics hub-Nangal Choudhary covering an area of 886 acres and IMC at Hisar covering 1,605 acres.

"The proposed Integrated Multi Modal Logistics Hub at Nangal Chaudhary in Haryana



is to be built on 886 acres. The work on road, water and electricity etc. related to this project has started and is expected to be completed by June. A target has been set to soon float the EPC tender for the Internal Rail Yard Infrastructure," informed Khattar.

On the Industrial Manufacturing Cluster (IMC) Hisar to be developed on 1,605 acres of land, the Chief Minister said that in principle approval had been given for the CLU. Environment clearance will

also be completed soon. This project is also progressing at a fast pace.

Khattar said that the State Government will soon send a DPR for Inland Container Depot at Kalanaur, Yamunanagar to the Centre so that the work on this project can also begin. He said that the National Industrial Corridor Programme will help industrialisation and logistics in the state, which will lead to economic progress not only for the state but for the country.

## Himachal CM bats for full-fledged Integrated Regional Office of the Ministry of Environment at Shimla

Himachal Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu on Tuesday called on Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Bhupendra Yadav at New Delhi and requested for a separate and full-fledged Integrated Regional Office of the Ministry at Shimla. He also requested the Union Minister not to limit the same to sub-office so as to grant speedy forest clearances for projects of national importance like four Laning, strategic defence infrastructure etc.

Sukhu apprised the Union Minister that the State government is going to construct Rajiv Gandhi Day Boarding Schools in the state with a campus area of approx five hectares and requested for a limit of diversion of forest land under



the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 for construction of schools in hilly areas may be relaxed and may be enhanced up to 6 hectares in the case of Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) and 5 hectares in the case of Day Boarding Schools.

He also requested that the state government may be empowered to approve the diversion of forest land under

FCA 1980 for non-forestry purposes up to 5 hectares. Chief Minister apprised that state government has decided to construct heliports in all the districts of the state and the proposals are still pending with the Ministry and requested for speedy approvals on a priority basis.

The Union Minister assured of all possible assistance to state.

Political engagement between the countries is missing for some time now. The historicity of bilateral relations will depend on Prachanda's longevity as PM

**P**M Pushpa Kamal Dahal Prachanda will finally arrive today on a four days visit. Prachanda's first visit was a state visit when he came after the 10 April 2008 Constituent Assembly elections to 575 elected seats (out of 601) after the monarchy was dismantled and Nepal declared a federal democratic, secular republic. Prachanda who won peace after ten years of civil war, became Nepal's charismatic leader and beloved hero, his party winning 227 seats more than Nepali Congress (110) and CPN UML (103) combined.

It was a rude shock for India which had put its money on Nepali Congress. Still, it tried to adjust to Maoist ways to give Prachanda a grand welcome with the expectation that he would be sensitive to India's concerns and national interests. That hope was belied as Prachanda had ideas of a People's Republic chasing which he was forced to resign. The rest is a legend. In the second CA elections in November 2013, Maoists won 81 seats. Prachanda's second visit was in 2016-17 when he switched to NC from UML for power-sharing with NC PM Sher Bahadur Deuba. After the 2017 elections, Maoists won 53 seats and were forced to join the Left alliance which won a nearly two-thirds majority but Prachanda's hopes of becoming Prime Minister in a power-sharing deal with PM KP Oli never materialised.

In November 2022 elections his party slumped to 32 seats but all through the electoral cycles, CPN (Maoist Centre) even with declining numbers, remained the number 3 party – the kingmakers – with NC and UML alternating as the single largest party. Prachanda's reduced strength and power had not dimmed his ambition to be the prime minister. He demonstrated political dexterity in switching coalitions earlier this year to remain PM. Nepal's mixed electoral system makes a single-party majority unlikely. People

frustrated with the non-performance of older parties, voted TV anchor, Rabi Lamichhane, as leader of the fourth largest Rashtriya Swatantra Party (22

seats) and the rapper Balen Shah, Mayor of Kathmandu humbling NC, UML and Maoists.

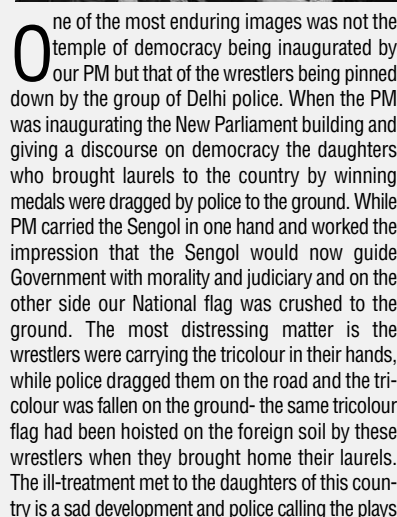
The three by-polls held in April in which RSP won two seats with overwhelming numbers including one from an NC stronghold have rung alarm bells for all political parties. Prachanda wants to revive the fortune of Maoists with India's help. That is why Prachanda wants to make his present visit historic and a game changer in India-Nepal relations for which he has to win back India's trust and most of all, the trust of the people of Nepal. He is now part of the eight-party coalition led by NC, along with CPN (Unified Socialist), Janata Samajwadi Party, Loktantrik Samajwadi Party, Janmat Party, Nagarik Unmukti Party and Rashtriya Jan Morcha. It is a different Prachanda who as Prime Minister leads the coalition and his party. He has to undo the pro-China image that he shed long ago that went unnoticed by New Delhi's political elite. This will not be easy in a Left-Right coalition.

Prachanda has to remould his party with a makeover of leadership. India should be impressed that Prachanda, unlike in 2008 when he went to China first, has this time declined Beijing's invitation for the Boao Forum in March and declared his intention to

Mindfulness can be practised by anyone irrespective of any faith or religion

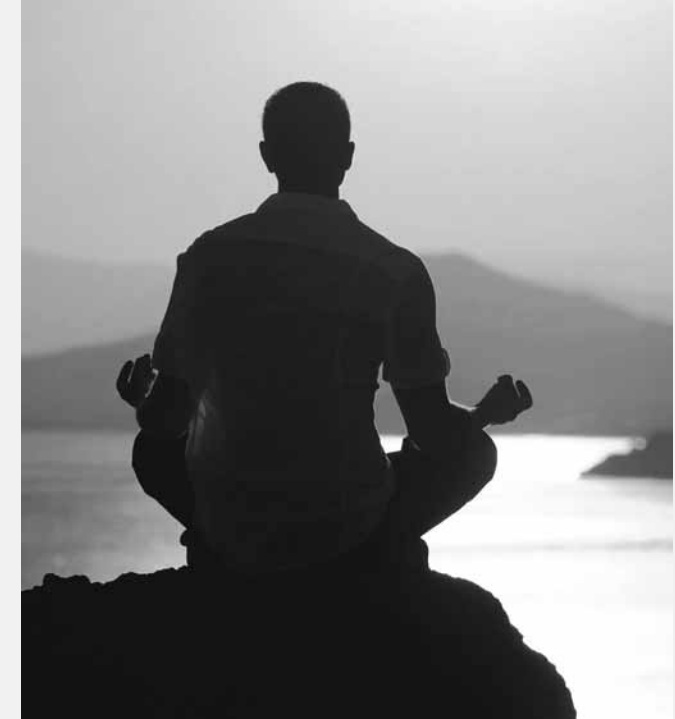

# Children with disabilities need robust policies for support

## The National Family Health Survey must include specific questions about disabilities to help formulate appropriate policy

India has 2.68 crore persons with a disability, according to the 2011 Census. However, with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, of 2016, now recognizing 21 types of disabilities, this number is expected to increase manifold. A robust policy is critical to encompass their aspirations and ensure all persons with disability achieve their full potential and play an active part in nation-building.

This is why the recent decision to drop questions related to disability from the sixth National Family Health Survey (NFHS), scheduled to begin on July 1, 2023, is inexplicable. The NFHS, conducted every three years, collects data on a gamut of development indices vital to inform policy and programmes.

This survey, which covers approximately seven lakh households across the country, is an important tool to gather data on whether people with disabilities have access to basic amenities and other government programmes.

However, at a time when the need to ensure no one gets left behind is doubly important considering the ravages caused by Covid, the exclusion of questions on disability is an opportunity lost to gather disaggregated disability data.

**An Opportunity Lost**

According to the Disability Rights India Foundation (DRIF), a non-profit working for disability rights, disability disaggregated data is the cornerstone for disability-relevant services. Instead of sharp-

ening its questionnaire related to disability, NFHS has reversed the process by removing disability-related questions altogether.

Considering that India is a signatory to the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD) and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), this regressive move contradicts its principle of "leaving no one behind" under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016. In India, PwDs experience an average loss of 10-17 years in life expectancy. Creating pathways to change this and make health services disability inclusive requires access to comprehensive health data which NFHS could have provided.

Children with disabilities are disadvantaged on most

measures of child well-being. In comparison to children without disabilities, children with disabilities are 24% less likely to receive early stimulation and responsive care; 42% less likely to have never attended school; 32% more likely to face corporal punishment; 47% more likely to be out of primary school, 33% more likely to be out of lower secondary school and 27% more likely to be out of upper secondary school; 51% more likely to feel unhappy and 41% likely to feel more discriminated against.

Now consider the fact that

one-third of disabilities in children are preventable if detected early and empowered with timely interventions. A roadmap based on accurate data to reach about 20.42 lakh children in the 0-9 age group with some form of disabilities, either congenital or acquired, could be life-changing.

It is no secret that existing disparities were exacerbated by Covid. In the context of education, data shows that before the pandemic, more than 4.1 million girls were not going to school across India. The closure of 1.5 million schools during the pandemic impacted over 247 million children enrolled in elementary and secondary schools, including 37 million with disabilities.

A 2020 survey by Swabhimana, a community-

based organization working for the rights of persons with disability, in Odisha, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Tripura, Chennai, Sikkim, Nagaland, Haryana and J&K found about 43% of children with disabilities planned to drop out due to hardships in online education.

It is not just the lack of access to educational aids that impedes the well-being of a PwD. They have little or no access to health services as information about disease symptoms and prevention, is not provided in accessible formats such as print materials in Braille, sign language interpretation, captions, audio provisions and graphics.

Women with disabilities are doubly marginalised on account of their disability and

their gender and face greater social barriers, discrimination and isolation. Moreover, women and girls with disabilities are three times more likely to experience gender-based violence compared to non-disabled women.

The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, emphasises prevention of disability through appropriate awareness measures, investigation, and research. Article 31 of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities mandates collection of appropriate information on PwDs to enable the formulation and implementation of policies. Can there be a better mechanism than the NFHS to gather data to understand the prevalence and pattern of disabilities?



# Khan appears before anti-terrorism court

Pakistan's former prime minister Imran Khan on Tuesday appeared before an anti-terrorism court in four cases, including the attack on Lahore Corp Commander House, and submitted surety bonds in connection with his pre-arrest bail till June 2.

"Khan appeared before the ATC Lahore judge Ijaz Ahmad Buttar and submitted surety bonds worth PKR 100,000 each in the four terrorism cases in which he had already been given pre-arrest bail till June 2," a court official told PTI.

As the 70-year-old chairman of the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party appeared in the court amid high security, a group of lawyers chanted slogans in his favour.

Khan's counsel also challenged the search warrants of the former premier's Zaman Park Lahore residence in the anti-terrorism court. The judge summoned the Punjab



police DIG (operations) for next hearing and directed him to submit a reply.

On May 9, violent protests erupted after the arrest of Khan by paramilitary Rangers in Islamabad. His party workers vandalised over 20 military installations and government buildings, including the Lahore Corps Commander House, Mianwali airbase and the ISI building in Faisalabad. The Army headquarters (GHQ) in Rawalpindi was also attacked by the mob for the first time. Khan was later released on bail.

## Sharif: Anarchists don't qualify for dialogue

**Islamabad (PTI):** Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif on Tuesday hinted that his government was unwilling to talk with Imran Khan's Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party, saying the "anarchists and arsonists" who wear the garb of politicians and attack the symbols of the state do not

Law enforcement agencies have arrested over 10,000 workers of Khan's Pakistan party across Pakistan, 4,000 of them from Punjab. Police put the death toll in violent clashes to 10 while Khan's party claims 40 of its workers lost their lives in the firing by security personnel.

Meanwhile, two lawyers of Khan appeared before a joint investigation team probing

the attack on Corps Commander House known as Jinnah House in Lahore. The joint investigation team - formed by the Punjab interim government to probe arson attacks on Jinnah House and the Askari Corporate Tower in Lahore on May 9 - had summoned Khan for Tuesday to record his statement but he sent his lawyers instead.

## JIT summons ex-Pak PM

**Lahore (PTI):** A joint investigation team probing the violent attack on the historic Corps Commander House or the Jinnah House here on May 9 has summoned former Pakistan prime minister Imran Khan on Tuesday. Khan, the chief of the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) party, has been asked to appear before the JIT at 4 pm at the Qilla Gujjar police headquarters in Lahore. He has been called for questioning in a case registered with the Sarwar Road police station against the attack. Jinnah House (Corps Commander House) was torched by arsonists following the anti-government protests against the arrest of Khan on May 9. A large number of PTI party workers May 9 stormed the Jinnah House and set it on fire after vandalising it.

## No meeting between US, Chinese defence chiefs, says Beijing

Prospects for a renewed high-level military dialogue between China and the US remain dim, with Beijing saying their defense chiefs will not hold a bilateral meeting while both are attending a weekend security conference in Singapore.

Foreign Ministry spokesperson Mao Ning on Tuesday blamed the US, saying Washington should "earnestly respect China's sovereignty and security interests and concerns, immediately correct the wrongdoing, show sincerity, and create the necessary atmosphere and conditions for dialogue and communication between the two militaries." Mao gave no details, but tensions between the sides have spiked over Washington's military support and sales of defensive weapons to self-governing Taiwan, China's assertions of sovereignty to the contested South China Sea and its flying of a suspected spy balloon over the US.

US Defence Secretary Lloyd Austin is scheduled to address the Shangri-La Dialogue on Saturday, while Chinese Defense Minister Gen. Li Shangfu will speak at the gathering on Sunday.

Austin met privately with Li's predecessor, Wei Fenghe, at last year's Shangri-La Dialogue, which appeared to do little to smooth relations between the sides. In his address to the forum, Wei accused the US of seeking to contain China's development and threatening to assert its claim to Taiwan by military force.

Chinese leader Xi Jinping and U.S. President Joe Biden met on the sidelines of the Group of 20 meeting of large economies in November in Indonesia, but contacts have proceeded only sporadically since then, with only side meetings on neutral territory.

Secretary of State Antony Blinken canceled a visit to Beijing in February after the US shot down a Chinese spy balloon that had crossed the United States.

He later met with the Communist Party's senior foreign affairs adviser Wang Yi in Austria.

China refused to take a phone call from Austin to discuss the balloon issue, the Pentagon said.

## China launches first spaceship with civilian

**Beijing/Jiuquan (PTI):** China on Tuesday successfully launched the Shenzhou-16 manned spaceship, sending three astronauts, including the first civilian to its space station combination for a five-month mission.

The spaceship, atop a Long March-2F carrier rocket, blasted off from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Centre in northwest China at 9:31 AM (Beijing Time), according to the China Manned



Space Agency (CMSA).

About 10 minutes after the launch, Shenzhou-16 separated from the rocket and entered its designated orbit. The crew members are in good shape and the launch is a complete success, the CMSA declared, it said. The astronauts are expected to dock with the station's Tianhe core module about 400km above the ground - after a journey of less than seven hours.

For the first time, China has included a civilian in its rotating crew for the space station which otherwise remained a domain of the military personnel. Gui Haichao, a professor at Beihang University in Beijing regarded as a payload specialist was among the three astronauts.

The other two are mission's commander Jing Haipeng, who is also making history by becoming the first Chinese astronaut to go into space for a record fourth time.

The astronaut flight engineer Zhu Yangzhu is also making his first journey into space.

The Shenzhou-16 will be the first crew mission after China's space station programme entered the stage of application and development, Lin Xiqiang, deputy director of the CMSA told the media on Monday. The trio will stay in orbit for about five months, he said.

Once ready, China will be the only country to own a space station as the International Space Station (ISS) of Russia is a collaborative project of several countries. The ISS station is also set to be decommissioned by 2030.

The significant feature of China's space station is its two robotic arms, especially the long one which has the ability to grab objects, including satellites from space. After entering orbit, the Shenzhou-16 spaceship will make a fast, automated rendezvous and docking with the space station combination.

## Musk meets Chinese FM

**Beijing:** China's foreign minister met Tesla Ltd. CEO Elon Musk on Tuesday and said strained US-Chinese relations require "mutual respect," while delivering a message of reassurance that foreign companies are welcome.

US-Chinese relations are especially tense after Washington shot down a Chinese balloon believed to be gathering intelligence and warned Beijing against supplying arms to Russia for its war against Ukraine. The Wall Street Journal reported China has rejected a request for its defense minister to meet the U.S. defense secretary when both are in Singapore this weekend.

"We need to keep the steering wheel in the right direction of mutual respect, peaceful coexistence and win-win cooperation," Qin Gang told Musk, according to a ministry statement. The two sides should "avoid dangerous driving," Qin said. He gave no details of steps to improve relations.

# Russia: Moscow buildings lightly damaged, while Kviy bombarded

**AP ■ KIVY**

A rare drone attack jolted Moscow early Tuesday, causing only light damage but forcing evacuations as residential buildings were struck in the Russian capital for the first time in the war against Ukraine.

The Kremlin, meanwhile, pursued its relentless bombardment of Kyiv with a third assault on the city in 24 hours.

The Russian Defence Ministry said five drones were shot down in Moscow and the systems of three others were jammed, causing them to veer off course.

President Vladimir Putin called it a “terrorist” act by Kyiv. The attack, causing only what Moscow Mayor Sergei Sobyenin called “insignificant damage” to several buildings, brought the war home to civilians in Russia’s capital.

Two people received treatment for unspecified injuries but did not need hospitalisation, he said in a Telegram post, adding that residents of two high-rise buildings damaged in the attack were evacuated.

Andrei Vorobyov, governor of the wider Moscow region, said some of the drones were “shot down on the approach to Moscow.”

Ukraine made no direct comment on the attack, which would be one of its deepest and most daring strikes into Russia since the Kremlin launched its full-scale invasion of Ukraine more than 15 months ago.

Putin said Moscow’s air defense “worked in a satisfactory way,” but added it is “clear that our task is to plug the gaps” in the system.

## 9 hurt in shooting near beach in Hollywood

**Hollywood (US):** Nine people were injured Monday evening when gunfire erupted along a beach boardwalk in Hollywood, Florida, sending people frantically running for cover along the crowded beach on Memorial Day.

Several of the victims were taken to a children’s hospital, police spokesperson Deanna Bettineschi said. However, authorities have not yet released the ages of the victims.

The nine victims included six adults and three children, according to Yanet Obarrio Sanchez, a spokesperson for Memorial Healthcare System. All of the victims were in stable condition, she said.

A preliminary investigation shows that an altercation between two groups resulted in gunfire, police said. One person has been detained and another suspect is being still being sought.

The shooting happened about 6:30 p.m. on the boardwalk near a convenience store, a Ben & Jerry’s ice cream store and a Subway sandwich shop.

Alvie Carlton Scott III said he was on the beach when all of a sudden he heard numerous gunshots go off. He said he hid behind a tree and then fled the area after a police officer told people to run.

Jamie Ward, who was also on the boardwalk, said several young men were fighting in front of the stores when one pulled a gun and started shooting. Videos posted on Twitter on Monday evening showed emergency medical crews responding and providing aid to multiple injured people.

“The Kyiv regime ... attempts to intimidate Russian citizens and strikes at civilian buildings,” he said at a public event, responding to a question from the head of a Kremlin-allied think tank.

“It is, of course, a clear indication of terrorist activity,” Asked by The Associated Press whether there is high-level concern that the invasion of Ukraine is endangering Russian civilians, Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said only that attacks on Russia reinforce the need to prosecute the war.

Russian political analyst Tatiana Stanovaya, a senior fellow at the Carnegie Russia Eurasia Center, said the Kremlin’s policy is to play down the attacks.

“You ask, why is Putin behaving like this, does he really not understand and fear the consequences?” she wrote in a Telegram post.

# Crucial days ahead as debt ceiling deal goes for vote

## Biden calls lawmakers for support

**AP ■ WASHINGTON**

President Joe Biden says he “feels good” about the debt ceiling and budget deal negotiated with House Speaker Kevin McCarthy as the White House and congressional leaders work to ensure its passage this week in time to lift the nation’s borrowing limit and prevent a disastrous US default. Biden spent part of the Memorial Day holiday working the phones, calling lawmakers in both parties, as the president does his part to deliver the votes.

A number of hard right conservatives are criticising the deal as falling short of the deep spending cuts they want-

ed, while liberals decry policy changes such as new work requirements for older Americans in the food aid programme.

A key test will come Tuesday afternoon when the House Rules Committee is scheduled to consider the package and vote on sending it to the full House for a vote expected Wednesday. “I feel very good about it,” Biden told reporters Monday as he left Washington for his home in Delaware.

“I’ve spoken to a number of the members,” he said, among them Senate Republican leader Mitch McConnell, a past partner in big bipartisan deals who largely sat this one out.

“I spoke to a whole bunch of people, and it feels good,” Biden said. To those progressive Democrats raising concerns about the package, the president had a simple message: “Talk to me.”

As lawmakers size up the 99-page bill, few are expected to be fully satisfied with the final product.

But Biden, a Democrat, and McCarthy, a Republican, are counting on pulling majority support from the political centre, a rarity in divided Washington, to join in voting to prevent a catastrophic federal default. Wall Street will open early Tuesday morning delivering its own assessment, as the US financial markets that had been closed when the deal was struck over the weekend show their reaction to the outcome.

McCarthy acknowledged the hard-fought compromise with Biden will not be “100% of what everybody wants” as he leads a slim House majority powered by hard-right conservatives. Facing potential blowback from his conservative ranks, the Republican speaker will have to rely on upwards of half the House Democrats and half the House Republicans to push the debt ceiling package to passage.

## Sunak clamps down on free vapes for children

**PTI ■ LONDON**

“My daughters are 10 and 12, and I don’t want the way vapes are marketed, promoted and sold to be attractive to them,” British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak said on Tuesday as he launched a crackdown to protect children from “rogue companies and online crooks”.

Announcing the new set of measures aimed at curbing under-age vaping, Sunak said expressed his shock at reports of illicit vapes containing lead getting into the hands of schoolchildren.

Taking to Twitter, the father of schoolgirls Anousha and Krishna said: “My daughters are 10 and 12, and I don’t want the way vapes are marketed, promoted and sold to be attractive to them.” “That’s why I am launching a new crackdown today to protect children and go after the rogue companies and online crooks who are putting vapes into their hands,” he said. A loophole that allows retailers to give free samples of vapes to

# Jadeja proved fairy tales exist in sport: Fleming

Stephen Fleming doesn't believe in fairy tales in sport but Ravindra Jadeja's near-improbable heist that took Chennai Super Kings to its fifth IPL trophy might come closest to it.

With 13 needed to win in the final over against Gujarat Titans, CSK managed only three runs off the first four balls before Jadeja smashed Mohit Sharma for a six and a four off the last two deliveries to literally snatch the Cup from Gujarat's grasp.

"They say there are no fairy tales in the sport, but it was a pretty good one today. It has been a bit difficult 18 months where, as the captaincy was difficult, the injury was difficult, it took a bit of time from out of the game for him to come back into and be reintegrated into the Test side, and then re-integrate into CSK," Fleming told the media after Chennai defeated Gujarat Titans in the IPL final here.

In fact, Fleming had in his mind conceded defeat before final two deliveries were bowled by Mohit and the Jadeja turned it all.

"We have lost finals on the last ball which is an absolute heartache. I was gearing up myself for another heartache when Jaddu hit one for six and there could have been more heartache or more joy, I was not sure.

"But when I saw the ball go down, finally there was pure joy. This competition takes you to emotional levels that you cannot imagine," the Kiwi added.

Fleming has all praise for Jadeja's firepower.

"He plays a great role with



the ball, but we have got so much fire power, that some ways we use him down the order, but something has to give. MS (Dhoni) has been very supportive and proactive in getting him up there and today he repaid that faith," Fleming added.

The former New Zealand skipper explained Jadeja's shot selection.

"The six, I think, in particular of the ball which was pretty close to being perfect, was defining, and then left-handed drive to the fine leg. It was a great way to finish it. I couldn't be more happy for him. There has been some frustration at

times, but he is our gun player, he is a No 1 ranked player and today he delivered," Fleming added.

The CSK coach said his side was poor in the field in the first half, but kept getting better and confident as the rain-affected match panned out.

"215... I thought it was an excellent score but the rain came and we had to change the momentum. We felt with the moisture around on the pitch, it was gettable. It was going to take a lot of batting.

"The start was really important because we were still shell-shocked from the fielding. The first four or six overs started to

give us the belief and once we got a little bit of taste for it, it is that type of ground where it is very hard to defend, so we knew we had a chance. It was going to be high octane all the way through," Fleming added.

Fleming praised Gujarat Titans bowlers Mohammad Shami and Mohit Sharma for taking the contest into the final ball of the match.

"The last couple of overs were very tight. Shami and Sharma bowled well, Mohit Sharma in particular has been very good," he said.

Cricket has always been a game of fine margins, believes Fleming, who has been CSK

coach for a decade and half now.

"I think I said it a couple of days ago that this tournament is being defined by fine margins. I think the last couple of balls summed that up — if you just missed a yorker or go down the leg side.

"We have talked about that all the way through, that if you can just get on the right side of those moments, then we can stay in and it was one of those days," Fleming said.

## PRaise for RAHANE

Fleming heaped praise on senior India batter Ajinkya Rahane, who turned out to be one of the success stories for the

CSK side with an incredibly successful season with the bat. What changed was Rahane's philosophy of not trying to be an anchor batter.

"My understanding is that we got rid of the tag of being the guy you bat around or bat through. I think that maybe hung over his head a little bit too much and didn't allow him to be the player that he can be.

"And once that tag was gone, when I turned up halfway through the pre-season training, I saw a guy who was in magnificent form," Fleming said.

Fleming said that Rahane didn't feature in their initial plan.

"He wasn't in our initial thoughts, but the game in Mumbai was really defining. It was one of our best wins in the tournament and he was the big catalyst behind it, so he cemented that No. 3 spot.

"He has been unwavering the whole way through he's been nothing but positive, his nets have been positive. Anytime he's been caught on the boundary or out playing a big shot, we've just reinforced how good he's playing. So a little bit of belief and just sheer ability — he's been a wonderful player for us this year," he said.

## 'RAYUDU WOULD LEAVE A BIG HOLE'

The former New Zealand captain said Ambati Rayudu, who announced his retirement after this IPL final, will leave a big hole in their side.

"Ambati Rayudu has been an absolute legend. I rate him so highly as a batter and those three balls against Mohit Sharma today proved against one of the most in-form bowlers... to hit him for 6, 4 and 6 was sheer

# Hard thing would be to work hard for nine months and try to play another IPL: Dhoni

Chennai Super Kings' triumphant captain Mahendra Singh Dhoni has not yet ruled out playing in the IPL next year but said his body will have to hold up to feature in yet another season.

Under the 41-year-old Dhoni's leadership, CSK won a record-equaling fifth IPL title with a five-wicket victory over Gujarat Titans in the summit clash here on Monday.

"Circumstantially, this is the best time to announce my retirement. But the amount of love I

have received all over, the easy thing would be to walk away from here, but the harder thing would be to work hard for nine months and try to play another IPL," Dhoni said after the final.

Dhoni has been the cynosure of all eyes ever since the Indian Premier League began this year and in a fitting end to the finale, the captain finished with a record-levelling fifth trophy. His fans from across the country went to the venues in large numbers to cheer for him, chanting his name wherever CSK have played this season.

"It would be a gift from me, won't be easy on the body. You do get emotional, the first game at CSK everyone was chanting my name. My eyes were full of water, I needed to take some time off in the dugout.

"I realised I need to enjoy this. I think they love me for what I am, I don't try to portray something I'm not. Just keep it simple," Dhoni said.

Speaking about the final, Dhoni said, "Every trophy is special, but what is special about IPL is every cricket game you need to be ready. There were lapses today, the bowling department didn't work, but it was the batting department that took the pressure off them today.

"I do get frustrated, it is human but I try to step into their shoes, every individual deals with pressure differently. Ajinkya (Rahane) and a few others are experienced, so you don't worry. If anyone is confused, then can always ask."

# Destiny had this written for him: Hardik on Dhoni leading CSK to fifth IPL title

Gujarat Titans skipper Hardik Pandya paid rich tributes to his mentor and rival captain MS Dhoni, saying "destiny had this written for him" to lead Chennai Super Kings to a record-equaling fifth IPL title in what could be his last season in the lucrative league.

CSK beat GT by five wickets in a thrilling rain-affected summit showdown with Ravindra Jadeja smashing a six and a four off the last two balls to chase down a revised target of 171 in 15 overs here on Monday.

Jadeja, who remained not out on 15 off just six balls, dedicated the title win to his skipper Dhoni. "I would like to dedicate this win to a special member of the CSK side, MS Dhoni," Jadeja said.

"Feels amazing, winning my fifth title in front of my home crowd. I'm from Gujarat, and it's a special feeling. This crowd has been amazing. They were waiting for rain to stop till late night, I'd like to say a big congratulations to the CSK fans who came to support us."

On his six and four off the last two balls, Jadeja said, "I was just thinking I need to swing hard, as much as I can. Where the ball will go, I was not thinking about that, just looking

ing to swing hard.

"I was backing myself and looking to hit straight, because I know Mohit can bowl those slower balls."

GT failed to defend their title but Pandya said he would not have asked more from the team.

"We tick a lot of boxes and played with our heart. We've always been a team that has stood together and no one gave up. We win together and we lose together. Maybe one of those games today. I'm not one of those guys who makes excuses. CSK played better cricket.

"Special mention to Sai as well. He is going to do wonders in his life. I'm really happy for the guys. We've been backing them and their success has been their success. Mohit, Shami, Rashid everyone, the way they put their hand up. Special mention to the coaching staff as well. I can't ask anything more from them."

This is the lowest ratio among all banks having total business above Rs 3 lakh crore not just in public sector banks (PSBs), according to published yearly numbers of banks. Pune-based state-owned lender was followed by HDFC Bank with net NPA falling to 0.27 per cent and Kotak Mahindra Bank clinching the third spot with 0.37 per cent of net advances. On the PSB sides, BoM was followed by country's biggest lender State Bank of India (SBI) with net NPAs falling to 0.67 per cent and Bank of Baroda at 0.89 per cent at the end of March 2023.

BoM has provided almost completely for the NPAs and has highest Provision Coverage Ratio at 98.28 per cent followed by UCO Bank at 94.50 per cent and Indian Bank 93.82 percent. With regard to Capital Adequacy Ratio, BoM has 18.14 per cent highest among PSBs followed by Punjab & Sind Bank at 17.10 per cent and Canara Bank at 16.68 per cent as on March 31, 2023.

# MEDVEDEV OUT OF FRENCH OPEN

World number two Daniil Medvedev was knocked out of the French Open in the first round on Tuesday, losing in five sets to 172nd-ranked Thiago Seyboth Wild of Brazil.

Seyboth Wild, who came through the qualifiers and had never previously won a Grand Slam match, triumphed 7-6 (7/5), 6-7 (6/8), 2-6, 6-3, 6-4. It was Medvedev's fifth loss in the opening round at Roland Garros in seven appearances.

"I have watched Daniil play in my junior years. It's a dream come true to beat these kinds of players on this court," said the 23-year-old Brazilian who unleashed 69 winners past the Russian.

"I just wanted to get my angles right, get to the net as much as possible and use my forehand as much as possible against his — I guess it worked pretty well." He added: "I was cramping in the second set and couldn't really serve the way I wanted to but I tried to play my best tennis. I'm really happy with the way I played."

Seyboth Wild, without a win on the main tour since February 2022, had squandered two set points which would have given him a two-sets lead.

Medvedev made him pay, levelling the tie and then claiming a double break in the third set.

But the Brazilian hit back, a double break of his own in the fourth set levelling the clash as a fractious Medvedev bickered with the crowd.

In the final set, Seyboth Wild twice saw breaks retrieved by the Russian before he finally backed up a third break with a hold for 5-3.

He held his nerve to clinch the four-hour 15-minute match courtesy of two giant forehands and will face either Guido Pella or Quentin Halys for a place in the last 32.

Medvedev arrived in Paris buoyed by winning his first ever clay court title at the prestigious Italian Open last week for his fifth trophy of 2023.

But he has endured a bitter-sweet relationship with the French Open, losing in the first round in his first four visits. He ended that streak with a run to the quarter-finals in 2021.

**ZVEREV WINS**

Alexander Zverev made a winning return to Roland Garros on Tuesday with a straight-sets win over Lloyd Harris in the French Open first round,



12 months since suffering a serious ankle injury in the semi-finals.

The German had to retire injured from a dramatic last-four clash with Rafael Nadal last season after twisting his ankle and did not play again in 2022.

That match had already reached three hours and was locked at 6-6 in the second set after Nadal won a first-set tie-break when Zverev suffered torn ankle ligaments and had to be taken off Court Philippe Chatrier in a wheelchair.

Zverev, who was the third seed last

year, is only seeded 22nd this time around after struggling to recapture his best form since returning to the ATP Tour.

But the former US Open finalist had enough to beat South African Harris 7-6 (8/6), 7-6 (7/0), 6-1.

"It's nice to be back. I've marked this day in bold on my calendar since last year," Zverev said.

"I was obviously very disappointed with how that tournament ended for me (last year).

"That's why I think I appreciate even more when I play in a full stadium and the crowd is behind me."

Zverev went out in the first round in 2017 and needed five sets to win his opening tie at Roland Garros in both 2019 and 2021.

"No (not happy with his performance). But I'm happy that I won in three sets. Normally I start with five-set matches so I'm happy to win in three."

Zverev will next face Slovakia's Alex

Molcan as he tries to reach the third round for a sixth straight year.

He came back to the Tour at the start of 2023 but has since slipped from 12th to 27th in the rankings.

Zverev, who has won three of his five Masters titles on clay, failed to reach the quarter-finals in each of Monte Carlo, Madrid and Rome this season.

"Get some more wins. Get six more wins in the next two weeks," said the Olympic champion when asked what he wants to improve.



## Van der Sar to quit as Ajax chief after 'tough period'

Former Netherlands goalkeeper Edwin van der Sar on Tuesday announced that he was quitting as Ajax chief executive, after "an incredibly tough period" of more than a decade at the helm of the Amsterdam powerhouse.

Van der Sar's resignation comes on the back of the worst season in 14 years for the top Dutch club which finished third in the Eredivisie after a 3-1 drubbing by FC Twente on Sunday.

"After almost 11 years on the board, I am done," Van der Sar, 52, said in a statement.

"We have experienced wonderful things together, but it has also been an incredibly tough period," the former Manchester United 'keeper said, who retired from professional football in 2011. Ajax have failed to qualify for the Champions League after finishing third in the Eredivisie behind Feyenoord and PSV Eindhoven.

Media reports including the NOS public broadcaster and daily tabloid De Telegraaf said supporters held Van der Sar responsible for the club's drop in success, following the departure of sporting director Marc Overmars and trainer Erik ten Hag.

Former Dutch international Overmars quit after admitting sending inappropriate messages to female staff at Ajax, while the successful Ten Hag left for Manchester United in April last year.

Van der Sar said he needed to "take some distance, to get some rest, and to do other things."

Ajax supervisory board chairman Pier Eringa said the club "wanted Edwin to stay, but he had made his decision. We have to respect that."

Van der Sar's contract ran until June 30, 2025.

"The last season does not reflect the entire period that he has been in charge of Ajax," Eringa stressed.

Regarded as one of the world's all-time best goalkeepers, Van der Sar played for Ajax from 1990-1999, winning the Champions League in 1995.

He went on to lift the European Cup again in 2008 with Manchester United after spells at Juventus and Fulham.

Van der Sar returned to Ajax in 2012 as director of marketing before being promoted four years later to CEO. He is also the second-highest capped Netherlands player of all-time with 130 international appearances.
