

BJP rolls out stalwarts on Lok Sabha 2024 pitch

oping to get a massive first mover advantage as it works towards its target of winning 370 seats in the upcoming Lok Sabha elections, the BJP on Saturday released its first list of 195 Lok Sabha candidates from 16 States and two Union Territories (UT), days after a marathon meeting of the party Central Election Committee (CEC) chaired by Prime

Minister Narendra Modi. As many as 34 Ministers and two former Chief Ministers are on the list, which also includes 28 women, 47 leaders under the age of 50, 57 members from the OBC community, 27 from Scheduled Castes community and 18 from

Scheduled Tribe community. Of the 195 candidates, 51 are from the all important State of Uttar Pradesh, 20 from West Bengal and five from Delhi.

The list includes the party heavyweights PM Narendra Modi, who will be contesting from Varanasi for the third time, Home Minister Amit Shah, who will be fielded again from Gandhinagar in Gujarat, Union Women and Child Welfare Minister Smriti

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Congress, RJD using Dalits as shield to justify corruption: Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday launched a frontal attack on the Congress-RJD combine in Bihar, charging it with using Dalits and other deprived sections of the society as a "shield to justify their dynastic politics and corruption"

Addressing a rally in Begusarai district of the state, Modi also made veiled references to the land-for-jobs scam, pertain-ing to RJD president Lalu Prasad's tenure as the railway minister in the previous UPA government. He alleged that the Congress-RJD combine was guilty of "betrayal of social justice". The PM also asserted that

social uplift was brought about by his government which worked for the progress of all. Modi, who spoke in the presence of Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar, hailed the JD(U) president as a true champion of social justice, like the latter's mentor Karpoori Thakur who was recently given the Bharat Ratna by the Centre.

The prime minister was speaking after the launch of development projects worth more

than Rs 1.5 lakh crore. Ahead of the Lok Sabha polls, the prime minister also exuded confidence that the NDA, which was running a "double engine" government in Bihar, would sweep the elections across the country.

Modi targets TMC in Bengal, renews BJP 400 seats target

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday set a 400 seat target for the BJP in the coming Lok Sabha elections saying only the saffron outfit had the integrity and courage to rid India of corrupt parties like the Trinamool Congress. Picking up from where he left

at Arambagh on Friday the Prime Minister said the TMC --- in the context of the trail of corruption that it has left in Bengal --- should stand for "Tu, Mein air Corruption" (you, me and corruption). Hailing the "massive turnout"

in the rally and seeing it as a prelude to the BJP's target of 400 seats the Prime said, "your presence in such large numbers gives me confidence to declare that BJP sarkar 400 paar (BJP government will cross the 400-seat marks in parliament).'

The Prime Minister was addressing a massive rally at the historical town of Krishnagar in Nadia district which also associated with the Bhakti saint Chatanya Mahaprabhu.

Launching a scathing attack on the TMC for perpetrating a dynastic politics coated with corruption and identified by the atrocities that they have heaped on the people of Bengal Modi said, "the TMC is synonymous with crime, corruption and dynastic politics which has left the people

of Bengal in a quandary." The Krishnagar seat was won by TMC's expelled Lok Sabha



MP Mohua Moitra in 2019 and assumes importance in that context.

Apparently raising the Sandeskhali issue and the delayed apprehension of the TMC strongman Sheikh Shahjahan accused of largescale land grab and sexual assault on women, Banerjee said, "this is a government which promotes the corrupt ... They failed to save the interest of distressed mother's and sisters of the area."

He said that though the TMC took voted in the name of Maa, Maati and Manush (Mother, land and humanity) they had betrayed their interest in the first instance.

Continuing to hit the Trinamool where it hurt the most post allegations that it's leaders had grabbed large swathes of land and sexually women, the Prime Minister said that "the mothers and sis-

ters continued to cry for help but this government looked the other way '

In an apartment reference to Shahjaĥan who was arrested 56 days after the commission of crime the Prime Minister said that in Bengal it were the criminals who decide when to be arrested," as they remain in protection of the police.

Modi has on Friday launched a scathing attack on the Indian National Democratic Alliance in reference to the Sandeskhali incident saying the entire INDIA alliance watched silently as the women of the reverine island were sexually assaulted by the goons of the TMC.

bloc candidate and AAP leader Somnath Bharti, also a lawyer, Ramvir Bidhuri will face AAP leader Sahi Ram Pehalwan.

Soon after her name was announced, Swaraj said that she will try to live up to the legacy set by her mother, who she was sure sent her blessings from heaven. "I know I have the blessings of Ma (Sushma Swaraj). But this achievement does not belong to Bansuri Swaraj, but to every karyakarta (worker) of Delhi BJP," Swaraj told a media house. After being elected as a Legislator for the fourth time in 2020, Bidhuri was chosen as the leader of the BJP Legislative Party and became the Leader of Opposition in the Delhi

Legislative Assembly with the rank of a Cabinet Minister. Sehrawat was Mayor of South Delhi Municipal Corporation and is highly educated, hold-

ing the degree in Bachelors of Commerce Honours (B Com) & Masters of Commerce (M Com), graduate degree in education (B. Ed), degree in Law programme and a Diploma in computer application.

The party has preferred to repeat sitting MP Manoj Tiwari in North East Delhi. Tiwari is the BJP's Purvanchal face in the Capital. He won the North East Delhi (Lok Sabha constituency) in the 2014 general elections from BJP. He defeated Anand Kumar from AAP with a margin of 1,44,084 votes while in 2019 general elections, Tiwari, won against Congress stalwart and Delhi Chief Minister Sheila Dikshit in North East Delhi constituency of New Delhi by a margin of 3.63 lakh votes.In a surprising turn of events, former cricketer and East Delhi BJP MP Gautam Gambhir, one of the foremost critics of AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal, on Saturday announced that he will not be contesting in the upcoming Lok Sabha elections. He urged the BJP National

President Jagat Prakash Nadda, to relieve him of his political duties so that he can focus more on cricket as he is set to begin his tenure as the mentor of Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR). He, however,

"I have requested Hon'ble party president J P Nadda ji to relieve me of my political duties so that I can focus on my upcoming cricket commitments. I sincerely thank Hon'ble PM Narendra Modi ji and Home Minister Amit Shah ji for giving me the opportunity to serve the people. Jai Hind!," Gambhir said

on X. Hours before his sudden move, Gambhir shared on X a picture of the receipt for his donation to the BJP as his contribution to PM Modi's vision of building a 'Viksit Bharat' and urged all to join the drive.

Gambhir joined the BJP in March 2019 and has since emerged as a prominent fig-ure for the party in Delhi. He successfully contested and won the East Delhi seat in the 2019 Lok Sabha elections, securing a significant margin of victory with 6,95,109 votes. A member of two World Cupwinning India squads, Gambhir will be next seen as a Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) mentor in the upcom-

ing edition of the Indian Premier League (IPL), which begins later this month.

A BJP leader said that Gambhir's name did not figure on the final panel of potential candidates but leaders at the party's most senior level were batting for one more ticket for him. "His announcement to quit politics is completely unexpected," a party leader said

party leader said The East Delhi MP was involved in a spat with Gandhi Nagar MLA Anil Bajpai over different issues. Moreover, Gambhir's rela-tions with other leaders in his tions with other leaders in his constituency were less than cordial, he claimed.

As an MP, Gambhir pursued with vigour his initiatives of running a community kitchen to provide free meals to the poor, opening libraries and focusing on the removal of the Ghazipur garbage dump. In the 2020 Assembly polls, the BJP won eight seats, three of which -- Gandhi Nagar, Vishwas Nagar and Laxmi Nagar -- were under the East Delhi Lok Sabha constituency. The party also won 21 of 36 wards in the Municipal Corporation of Delhi polls. It was the highest among the seven parliamentary constituencies in the city.

Expedite release of funds to six Government schools, Atishi asks chief secretary

The Delhi Development Authority (DDA) on Saturday said Hassan has now even refused to take a two bed room and a living room DDA MIG Flat in Dilshad Garden. "On Friday night, four gov-

ernment officers, including an SDM, came and offered me a house in Dilshad Garden but I refused to accept it as they wanted me to shift on a temporary basis," Hassan said. "It was also not in writing. That house belongs to an NGO," Hassan said.

Delhi Lieutenant Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena, who had upon coming to know about his much feted role in the rescue operation of the workers entrapped in Silkyara-Barkot tunnel in Uttarakhand, as a special measure asked DDA to provide him with alternate housing free of cost.

Governor, when the Executive Magistrates, Karawal Nagar and Seemapuri, went to him

with the same on 01.03.2024, at 8.30 PM," the DDA said in a statement. Hours after the demolition, DDA officials offered Hassan to move to an EWS (economically weaker sections) flat at Narela, which is far from Khajoori Khas in northeast Delhi. Hassan rejected it saying it was "far and unsafe".On being asked why he is rejecting the second offer as Dilshad Garden is located near Khajoori Khas unlike far-flung Narela, he said the cost of his house, which was razed by the DDA (Delhi Development Authority), was more than Rs 1 crore and if the government wants to compensate, then the cost of the house should be matched. Reportedly, Hassan owns a company Rockwell Enterprises, whose employees dug the last stretch of the Uttarakhand Tunnel during the aforementioned rescue operation. He along with his wife and two children have been staying on a footpath and demonstrating against the drive. On Saturday, during the rain in Delhi, he made a video requesting people to come for his support.

Hassan said that his belongings and household articles are lying open in the rain. "Today is the third day of my demonstration, which will continue till I get the solution from the government," he said. Hassan further said that he had bought this plot from a private person for Rs 33 lakh in 2012-13. "After buying the plot, I invested about Rs 8 lakh to build the rooms and also gave money to the DDA employees. The cost of my house has now gone up to more than Rs 1 crore now," he claimed. Veer Dev Kaushik, who lives in the same locality of Khajoori Khas near Hassan's razed house, said the locality was regu-larised by the Delhi government several years ago, after which he along with many others invested money to buy the plots.

"Hassan had also invested and bought a plot here. But the corrupt DDA officials were still harassing him to get more money and when he failed to do so, his house was razed," Kaushik, a government official in Uttar Pradesh's health department, said.

Chadha, along with his brothers, managed the Chadha Group, which has been consolidated under the Wave brand. He ran a popular chain of multiplexes - under the Wave brand - in the National

Under the pact, it was agreed to amicably resolve all issues of the indigenous people of Tripura related to history, land and political rights, economic development, identity, culture and language, according to an official statement.

"I assure all stakeholders of Tripura that you won't have to fight for your rights anymore. The government of India will be two steps ahead in creating mechanisms to safeguard your rights," Shah said.

The home minister said no one can change history but everyone can learn from their past mistakes and move ahead. He said the TIPRA Motha and

all tribal parties have played a constructive role and the BJP government in Tripura also worked sincerely towards this agreement.

The tripartite agreement between Tripura Indigenous Progressive Regional Alliance, popularly known as TIPRA Motha, and the state and central governments was signed at North Block here.

Shah said under the guidance of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, another treaty has been signed furthering harmony in the Northeast.

"Delighted to announce the signing of a tripartite agreement resolving issues related to the economic development,

land rights and the identity of the indigenous people of Tripura," he said.

Shah said that under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government, 11 peace and boundary settlement agreements in Northeastern states were signed.

In 2019, a peace pact was signed with the National Liberation Front of Tripura (NLFT) and the agreement with TIPRA Motha is the last for the Northeast before going to the Lok Sabha polls, he

added. TIPRA Motha supremo Pradvot Debbarma was on a 'fast-unto-death' to demand a permanent solution to the problems of the indigenous eople.

Following assurance of the interlocutors of the Central government, he came to the national capital and agreed for the pact. Debbarma was one of the signatories of the agreement. Tripura Chief Minister Manik Shah was also present on the occasion.

The home minister said with this agreement, Tripura has moved forward to become a dispute-free Tripura.

As part of the agreement, it was agreed to constitute a Joint Working Group or Committee to work out and implement the mutually agreed points on all agreed issues in a time-bound manner to ensure an hon-

ourable solution.

Government issues advisory to label under trial AI models

Days after Google's AI plat-form's response to queries on Prime Minister Narendra Modi generated controversy, the government has issued an advisory for social media and other platforms to label under-trial AI models and prevent hosting unlawful content.

In an advisory issued to intermediaries/platforms on March 1, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology warned of criminal action in case of non-compliance. "All intermediaries or platforms to ensure that use of Artificial Intelligence model(s) /LLM/Generative AI, software(s) or algorithm(s) on or through its computer resource does not permit its users to host, display, upload, modify, publish, transmit, store, update or share any unlawful content," the advisory said.

All platforms, intermediaries and enabling software shall be

held accountable for any breaches, it added. "Noncompliance with provisions would result in penal consequences.

The advisory comes within days of Google's AI platform Gémini making uncharitable comments about Prime Minister Modi's policies. The response of Gemini to queries about the Prime Minister led to a strong reaction from the government, with Minister of State for IT Rajeev Chandrasekhar calling it a violation of IT laws.

for Union Minister Electronics and IT Rajeev Chandrashekhar on Saturday said, "The episode of Google Gemini is very embarrassing, but saying that the platform was under trial and unreliable is certainly not an excuse to escape from prosecution".

"I advise all platforms to openly disclose to the consumers and seek consent from them before deploying any under-trial, erroneous plat-

forms on the Indian public internet. Nobody can escape accountability by apologis-ing later. Every platform on the Indian internet is obliged to be safe and trusted," he further said. The advisory asked the enti-

ties to seek approval from the government for deploying under trial or unreliable artificial intelligence (AI) models and deploy them only after labelling them of "possible and inherent fallibility or unreliability of the output generated".

Use of under-testing / unreliable Artificial Intelligence model(s) /LLM/Generative AI, software(s) or algorithm(s) and its availability to the users on Indian Internet must be done so with the explicit permission of the Government of India and be deployed only after appropriately labelling the possible and inherent fallibility or unreliability of the output generated," it said.

◄he outcome of the 13th ministerial conference and India is "completely satisfied" as the country continues to retain its full policy space to protect the interests of farmers and fishermen in every respect, Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal has

said. He said that New Delhi's procurement of food grains for distribution among the poor continues uninterrupted and without any hindrance.

"India continues to retain full policy space for the benefit of our farmers, our fishermen, and in every respect, we have been able to take India's interests to the highest level possible," the minister told reporters here after the fiveday meeting of the trade ministers of 166-member World Trade Organisation

(WTO). As the members were not able to reach consensus on key issues such as agriculture and fisheries subsidies, the talks that were scheduled to end on February 29 got extended for

a day. The talks at the WTO's ministerial conference ended with no decision on issues such as finding a permanent solution to public food stockpile and on curbing fisheries subsidies, but the members agreed to further extend the moratorium on imposing import duties on ecommerce trade for two more

vears. The ministerial conference, the highest decision making body of the WTO, also managed to get more outcomes such as new disciplines on domestic country did not yield any regulation for services, formal joining of Comoros and Timor-Leste as members of WTO, and least the



developing countries continuing to get the benefits of LDC even three years after graduation. India successfully pushed the food security issue and the

ground on protecting the interest of poor farmers and fishermen as well as on other

issues Goyal said that "it's a good

outcome and are we completely satisfied... A lot of issues continue to make progress in terms of discussions.

"Generally through the MC13, progress was made on several contentious issues which had not been closed for many years. Forward movement is always a sign of a possible closure going

forward," he said.

He added that in the proposed fisheries subsidies agreement aimed to curb subsidies that lead to over capacity and over fishing, found India several ambiguities on the proposals that were on the table.

Some of the subsidies that certain countries give to their resource-poor fishermen resource-poor fishermen were sought to be excluded. Besides, definitions were not satisfactory and several areas where deeper consultations and greater degree of flexibility was required to ensure a fair and balanced agreement, were not possible in such a short period of time. "By and large, the objectives with which we had come to Abu Dhabi are largely met and we go back fully satisfied," he said, adding, "our largest interest was to protect our farmers and our fishermen, both of which we are strongly doing and that is

our offensive interest which we are actively pursuing." On further extension of the duty moratorium on ecommerce trade, the minister said that India was "not necessarily opposed" to it fully.

Since the members had not discussed the issues pertaining to the moratorium during the time between MC12 (happened at Geneva June 2022) and MC 13, such as its scope and its impact on different economies, "we believe that it's in the best interest that we continue this e-commerce moratorium", he said.

When asked about the effort of certain developed countries to push non-trader investment issues like facilitation agreement, environment and labour in the WTO, Goyal said India has been successful in making sure that such issues cannot become part of the WTO.

Global energy-related carbon emissions grew by 1.1 per cent in 2023, increasing 410 million tonnes (Mt) to reach a new record high of 37.4 gigatonnes (Gt) in 2023, the International Energy Agency (IEA) said on Friday

Certainly, the discussions I'm in at the moment are very much thinking about how we can optimise the calendar and how we can continue to grow crick-et around the world," Hockely told SEN Cricket.

The changes proposed in the blueprint document include additional windows for T20 leagues other than the Indian Premier League, alteration in the World Test Championship points system, 40-over ODIs, apprehensions about T20Is and an effort towards pooling of broadcast rights revenue for bilateral series.

Hockley, when asked about the report, denied suggestions that the powerful nations were turning a blind eve to Test cricket

CAN YOU share a bit about your journey into the film industry and how you got your start as an actress?

I was into theatre in college and that's where I discovered my love for acting. I moved to Mumbai with the intention of becoming an actor. In my initial days in the industry, I did a commercial which was directed by Anurag Kashyap and he offered me Gangs of Wasseypur. That's how my journey in cinema was kickstarted.

What motivated you to pursue a career in acting?

In school I used to keenly participate in extracurricular activities. Whether it was elocution, debates or plays. When I went to college, I was deeply attracted to theatre and was bitten by the acting bug. I moved to Mumbai with the dream of becoming an actor.

Of all the roles you've played so far, which one has been the most challenging, and why?

I have played roles which have challenged me as an actor and made me push myself out of my comfort zone. It's difficult to choose any one role. I thoroughly enjoyed playing both Mohsina and Jhilmil even though they belong to completely different worlds. In the recent past, whether it was Tarla, Monica, Shalini or Rani Bharti - they are all strong women who will not be deterred by society or it's norms and will rise above their circumstances with sheer will power and be unapologetic about their ambitions.

Can you tell us about any upcoming projects that you are excited about?

The third season of Maharani will be streaming soon. I think this is one of the only shows which has a female protagonist and has been commissioned for the third season. I am really looking forward to how people receive it.

How do you think the film industry has evolved during your career, especially in terms of roles for women and what changes would you like to see in the entertainment industry, particularly in Bollywood? It's important for every actor to figure out their own path. There always will be a plethora of roles to play and actors must choose roles that work for them. The parameters for choosing roles are one's own. The sets have more women in all departments of filmmaking. Even though it's still not a level plating field, for example, the pay gap between male and female actors is still an issue, the industry has space for everyone and is constantly evolving

How do you approach preparing for a new role? Are there any specific methods you follow?

Not really. For me, reading the script multiple times helps. I just follow the script and the director's vision. Of course as an actor I improvise where it makes sense. But, essentially, I rely on the script for shaping my role.

Balancing personal and professional life can be

challenging. How do you manage to maintain that balance? What are your favorite ways to unwind and relax when you're not working? I love sleeping. On days when I am not shooting, I am usually catching up on my sleep or hang out with my friends and family. In recent years, many actors have become advocates for social issues. Are there any causes that you are particularly passionate about? How do you see your platform as an actress contributing to social change or awareness? I made a film which addressed body shaming called Double XL. As an actor one is expected to fit a mould but I have never adhered to that. My film was about how the skills a person has is far superior and what matters more than the looks or the how much they weigh. There has always been a lot of pressure on women to look a certain way and I have always advocated against that thought process.

What advice would you give to aspiring actors who are looking to enter the film industry?

Every individual's journey is different and they have to write their own story. What worked for me might not work for someone else. Focus, determination and resilience are key qualities.

Are there any lessons you've learned in your career that you wish someone had told you earlier?

I am glad that I got the opportunity to be on the journey and experience it for myself.






NOTA: THE SILENT REVOLUTION OR THE ILLUSION OF CHOICE?

t's impeccable to christen NOTA in the truest sense of the word as the 'Sankat Mochan' of democracy in political Lanka, as each vote deserves a political Ayodhya, not a chaotic Lanka. With the 2013 judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India (PUCL v. Union of India), a firm position was set that in an exceedingly legal system, electors must be given the right to reject, which owes its genesis to freedom of speech and expression (Art. 19(1)(a)). For a democracy to survive in its true form it is essential that the best available men should be chosen as people's representative and if electors find none from the roaster to be suitable enough, negative voting is necessitated. However, the rationale behind the 2013 judgement of the Apex Court has failed to bear fruits. In a vibrant democracy, voter's choice must be of paramount and if they palpably reject all the contesting candidates, their choice should be empowered by way of a fresh election.




